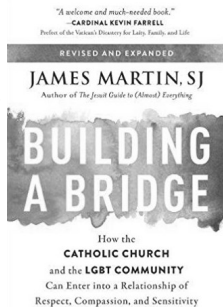

Our Parish has to give \$37,000 to support the work of the whole archdiocese.

So far \$13,402 has been pledged and \$8,522 paid. Thank you to those who have given!!!

But this means our current shortfall is approximately \$23,600 which will come out of our Parish savings if people don’t contribute.

Worst of all, of over 1,200 families in our Parish, so far only 40(!) families have participated or even pledged anything. That is not good and it reflects very poorly on us.
