THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Confessions are heard on Saturday afternoon at 4:00 PM and anytime upon reasonable request.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

First and third Sundays at 1:00 PM. Expectant parents may contact the parish office to arrange for the baptism seminar at 7:30 PM on the first Monday of the month to help them understand the beauty and responsibilities of the sacrament. Adults are baptized and confirmed at the Easter Vigil after completing the stages of the Rite of Christian Initiation.

THE SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Since Catholic marriage requires a time of preparation, arrangements should begin at least six months before the proposed date of the wedding to allow for the Marriage Preparation Program and Natural Family Planning (NFP). Registered, participating and contributing parishioners may contact the parish office to begin the process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

If you are planning to enter the hospital for surgery, experiencing a prolonged or serious illness, or are very weak due to advancement of age, call the parish office to arrange for the sacraments of reconciliation, communion and anointing at home, also available every Saturday morning at 9:00 AM Mass. Communal anointing of the sick is celebrated at Mass each April and October. Notify us or the Catholic chaplain at Good Samaritan, Helen Hayes and Nyack of any hospitalization so that we may be of assistance. Be sure to tell the admitting office that you are a Catholic patient and a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo parish.

PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL

is open all day and night for Eucharistic adoration and is located at the south end of the campus on Cinder Road in front of the parish house. Parishioners and friends are encouraged to become adorers or to stop in and spend some time in quiet prayer with the Lord.

OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD

All Christians are invited to pray a *NOVENA FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF HUMAN LIFE*. Our archbishop, Cardinal Dolan is the chairman of the United States Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities. He has called for a national prayer campaign effort that "the change in the US Supreme Court will move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life." The cardinal explained that as soon as Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy announced his retirement, pro-abortion groups began lobbying the US Senate to reject any nominee who does not promise to endorse *Roe v Wade*. While the US Conference of Catholic Bishops does not support or oppose the confirmation of any presidential nominee, it can and should raise grave concerns about a confirmation process which is being grossly distorted by efforts to subject judicial nominees to a litmus test of support for *Roe v Wade*. And we must pray.

He invited all people of goodwill to pray each Friday from August 3 to September 28 in a *NOVENA FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF HUMAN LIFE*. The USCCB said "Call to Prayer" materials will be accessible online. Materials include prayers and educational resources and an invitation to fast on Fridays for this intention.

If you wish to join this nine-week prayer effort, you can sign up at www.usccb.org/pray to participate in this and subsequent Call to Prayer initiatives via email or text message. May Our Lady of Guadalupe intercede for the healing of our nation and our people from decades of abortion on demand.

President Donald Trump announced on July 9 that his nominee for the Supreme Court is Judge Brett Kavanaugh, a federal appeals court judge in Washington and a Catholic who once clerked for retiring Justice Anthony Kennedy. In remarks at the White House after his nomination, Kavanaugh said if he is chosen to be on the Supreme Court, he would "keep an open mind in every case" and "always strive to preserve the Constitution of the United States and the American rule of law." Makes good sense to me.

Although we have moved into August, I hope you are still able to enjoy the relaxation that comes with this season. I am grateful for time to sit out on my porch and catnap in my rocking rocker, lulling me to sleep and rest and then some time for prayer.

holy water and a simple reception. Father will perform the symbolic tossing of the ceremonial wreath. This ceremony represents the "wedding" of the town and the Hudson River created by God in proximity to each other and blessed by His love and protection. Hope you can join us on next Sunday.

EMBER DAY FOR PEACE For centuries, the Church kept three days (Wednesday, Friday and Saturday) near the beginning of each season as a time of special penance. Such ember days echo the meaning and observance of Lent. Local churches and households may wish to observe these days of fasting, works of charity and prayers. August 6 and 9 are the anniversaries of the atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki. KEYS TO PARISH BUILDINGS Every few years, the *Catholic Mutual Group*, a national agency which provides insurance policies to parishes and schools within the archdiocese, asks us to account for the issuance and tracking of keys to parish buildings. Master keys are provided to all SGB regular staff personnel. Over the years, some parishioners or school parents have come into possession of building keys because of a specific responsibility and these have never been returned. If you have a master or entrance key to the school, gym, church or chapel, please return it to the parish office so that we can properly maintain the management of all building keys in compliance with our liability carrier.

GOING INTO THE HOSPITAL? Prior to entering the hospital for surgery or a procedure for you or a family member, please call the parish office requesting the sacrament of the anointing of the sick. It would be appropriate to give this blessing at one of the weekday Masses, if a person is capable of attending so that the community may join their prayers as well. Frequently, families wait too long until the person is in the hospital and restricted from food consumption. Therefore, they're unable to receive holy viaticum. Make sure the hospital knows you are a member of St. Gregory Barbarigo and that the chaplain has been invited to visit.
