## Lift Up Your Hearts

**January 8, 2017**  
**EPIPHANY OF THE LORD**

This Sunday we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord, in which our Gospel recounts how the Magi present our Lord with three gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Similarly, the prophet Isaiah describes people coming from the southern kingdom of Sheba bringing gifts of gold and frankincense.

Historically, the three gift express a symbolism and were far from arbitrary. Gold was the gift given to a king, as it was something valuable, beautiful, and durable. Frankincense was a gift given to a god, as this solidified tree resin was burned giving off a fragrant smoke which rises to heaven. Myrrh signified mortality, as this fragrant oil was used in preparing a body for burial. In presenting these gifts, the Magi are telling everyone that Christ is a king who is both human and divine. As king, he exercises authority. As God, he possesses all power. As human, he shares in our struggles and weaknesses. The gifts of the Magi reveal the identity of the child laying before them.

Isaiah helps us to see the role that the Christ-child will play in our lives. He describes the Christ as the light shining in the darkness of the world. But the light of Christ is not merely external to us. Rather, "we shall become as radiant as what we see." He describes those who see Christ as having their hearts filled to the point of overflowing.

All of this reminds us that the God revealed in Jesus Christ is not some distant external reality, but is someone whom we come to know personally and who operates within us. St. Augustine famously said, "Our hearts are restless Lord, until they rest in you." Everything that is good in our lives, is but a faint echo of goodness that points back to its origin: God. What is pivotal in the Christian faith is that we are invited into a personal relationship with God. This relationship is developed above all in prayer. Prayer is the lifting of one's mind and heart up to God. It begins by making a quiet space in our days to encounter God – even as little as 10 or 15 minutes a day is enough, as long as it is regular. Often our prayer takes as its inspiration, an image, or a reading from the scriptures (especially the Gospels), or some of the writings of the saints. As we allow our hearts to drink in these reminders of God, we allow ourselves to be moved. We observe the thoughts and emotions that the presence of God stirs within us and then begin to contemplate what they mean. Gradually we begin to grow more aware of the action of God's grace in our lives – recognizing how God has been moving us and discerning what direction he is leading us. More than simply *knowing about* God, we slowly come to *know* God, and in doing so come to know ourselves as well.

I pray that Christ will abundantly bless you this year with a rich awareness and understanding of his presence in your lives.

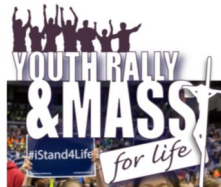
