The Lord's Promises

Here is one possible restatement of the Beatitudes, trying to capture their meaning as they enlarge our vision of our world.

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, those who realize their spiritual poverty and need for God. Theirs is the kingdom of God because they are open to the riches of God's kingdom. They know they are not spiritually self-sufficient, that the soul does not nourish itself. They know their need of God."

"Blessed are they who mourn, those who grieve over the depth of sin, pride and arrogance in their life and in the world, who are not deceived by the glitter of a superficial culture. They shall be consoled and will know the joy and renewal of forgiveness.

"Blessed are the meek, the humble, those who know and accept the real truth about themselves. They shall inherit the land, the spiritual possessions and the sense of place that come from the honest truth.

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for holiness. They are not pursuing a dream because in Christ their yearning will be filled.

"Blessed are those who show mercy, who don't just read about mercy and pray for mercy but who show mercy. They can be sure of God's mercy toward them.

"Blessed are the clean of heart, those whose motives are clear, unselfish and Christian. They shall see God with the same clarity.

"Blessed are the peacemakers, those who bring people together. They are doing God's work and they will be called sons/daughters of God."

In the Beatitudes, Jesus calls us to look beyond arrogance, selfishness and sin to see that the energy, the hope and the power of the kingdom are also at work in our world - often in places and people we don't notice. These are the "remnants" of whom Zephaniah speaks in the first reading, who are doing God's will and God's work every day.

The Beatitudes are also promises of "where" God will be for us. They describe moments in every human life that are blessed, where God is present and where salvation comes near to us, if we have the faith and trust to see it.

When we realize we are poor in spirit, when we sorrow over sin, when we are humble and honest about ourselves and in our relationships, when we hunger for holiness, when we show mercy, when we are motivated by the Gospel, when we are peacemakers and when we absorb hurt and insult and not just pass it on, the Lord promises us the graces and peace of the kingdom.

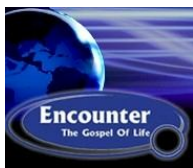
