SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

Teaching on Marriage

In the first reading this Sunday, we have the words "bones of my bones and flesh of my flesh". In the gospel we read "...from the beginning of creation male and female are no longer two, but one flesh". The key phrase is "from the beginning". Male and female can be one flesh before the fall of Adam and Eve. After the fall, division and rivalry begins. However, with the coming of Jesus Christ and the Kingdom of God, redemption of humanity from sin begins anew with conversion from sin and participation in the ecclesial community and sacraments. Jesus Christ addresses the "hardness of the heart" of people so that they may convert and marriage can again have its original "one flesh" meaning. This is one of the basic teachings of this Sunday.

But let us go even deeper. Jesus Christ is the New Adam and Mary is the new Eve. Mary is the symbol of the Church since she is the mother of all believers. When Jesus was at the cross, one of the soldiers pierced his side and water and blood came forth. Jesus Christ also tells us that we are "bones of his bones and flesh of his flesh" since we were born to new life through the waters of baptism and the blood at the Eucharist. We are his children born through water and blood of his side, as Eve came forth from the side of Adam.

Jesus is calling us to have this spousal relationship with us his Church, his bride. Every time we do not harden our hearts and we convert from our sins, we can become one flesh with Christ at the Eucharist. We eat his body and blood and become bones of his bones and flesh of his flesh. The original friendship that Adam and Eve enjoyed with God from the beginning was lost through original sin. However, this friendship, brotherhood, and spousal relationship was redeemed by Christ at the cross. We have access to this redemption, the forgiveness of our sins at our baptism and the participation at the Eucharist.

Enseñanza Sobre el Matrimonio

En este domingo, la primera lectura nos dice "hueso de mis huesos y carne de mi carne". El evangelio dice, "al principio de la creación Dios lo hizo hombre y mujer...y serán una sola carne". La frase clave es "al principio". Hombre y mujer pueden ser una sola carne antes de la caída de Adán y Eva en el pecado. Después de la caída, división y rivalidad comienza. Con la venida de Cristo y el reino de Dios, Cristo redime a la humanidad del pecado y comienza una nueva vida con la conversión de los pecados, la participación en la comunidad eclesial y los sacramentos. Cristo se dirige a la dureza del corazón del hombre por el pecado para que se conviertan y el matrimonio pueda de nuevo tener el significado de "una carne". Esta es una de las enseñanzas de este domingo.

Pero vayamos todavía más profundo. Jesús es el nuevo Adán y María es la nueva Eva. María es el símbolo de la Iglesia ya que es la madre de todos los creyentes. Cuando Jesús estaba en la cruz, uno de los soldados abrió el costado de Jesús con su lanza y al instante salió sangre y agua. Jesús nos dice también a nosotros que somos huesos de sus huesos y carne de su carne, somos su cuerpo. Nacimos a una nueva vida por las aguas del bautismo y la sangre en la Eucaristía. Somos sus hijos nacidos del agua y la sangre de su costado, así como Eva fue formada del costado de Adán.

Jesús nos llama a nosotros su cuerpo, su Iglesia, su esposa, a tener una relación esponsal con él. Cada vez que no endurecemos nuestro corazón y nos convertimos de corazón, podemos llegar a ser una sola carne con Cristo en la Eucaristía. Comemos su cuerpo y su sangre y así nos hacemos huesos de sus huesos y carne de su carne. La amistad de Adán y Eva con Dios al comienzo se perdió con el pecado original. Pero esta amistad, hermandad y relación esponsal fue redimida por Cristo en la cruz para el perdón de nuestros pecados en nuestro bautismo y participación en la Eucaristía.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Let's continue deepening our catechesis on the sacrament of reconciliation. Last week, a person actually asked me the difference between sins that are to be confessed before receiving communion and sins that are not grave enough to confess before communion.

I basically answered that there are venial and mortal sins. On the one hand, mortal sins destroy charity in the heart of man. The ten commandments inform us of grave sins as Jesus spoke to the rich young man in the gospel, do not kill, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not bear false witness, do not be unjust, honor your father and mother (CCC, 1855-1856). These sins must be confessed before receiving communion. On the other hand, venial sins weaken charity and manifest a disordered affection for earthly goods. Unrepented venial sins can little by little dispose us to commit mortal sins. For this reason, it is always advisable to confess venial sins sometimes (CCC, 1863). St. Augustine used to say: "a number of drops fills a river...what is our hope? Above all, confession." So, if one is sure of a grave sin, then come to confession. And if one is not sure of the sinful state of his soul, then come to confession too. Let's never think lightly about our sins. But above all, let's never doubt that Jesus is immensely merciful with our sins at the sacrament of confession.

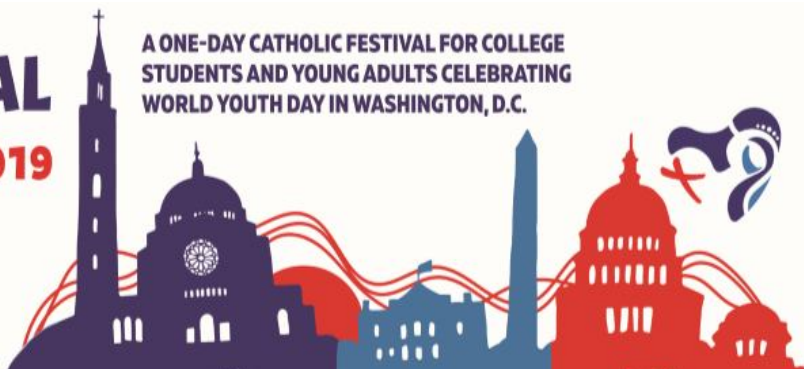

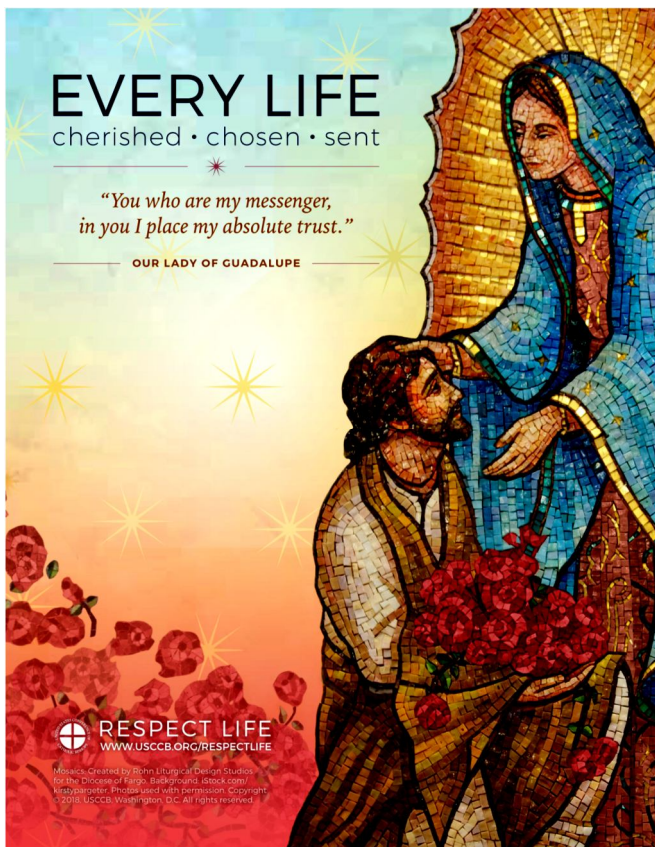

HOW ARE YOUR DONATIONS TO ST. ROSE USED?

We will soon publish our annual Stewardship Report, which provides details about the many good works that are made possible and the many lives impacted through your generous gifts to St. Rose. Here is information about the three main parish funds to which parishioners donate:

Offertory funds are used for the parish operating budget, providing support for all St. Rose programs and ministries (i.e. faith formation for children, youth, and adults; social concerns and outreach ministries; music and liturgical ministries), facilities and maintenance expenses, staff salaries and benefits, and more.

The Offertory fund is subject to assessment by the Archdiocese at a rate of 12%, plus 3% for the Archdiocesan Schools Fund.

Debt Reduction/Mortgage funds are used to pay down the loan debt for the building of our church, completed in 2006.

Capital Campaign funds are for construction of the Gathering Space and to further pay down our loan debt.

Both the Debt Reduction/Mortgage and Capital Campaign funds are exempt from assessment by the Archdiocese.
