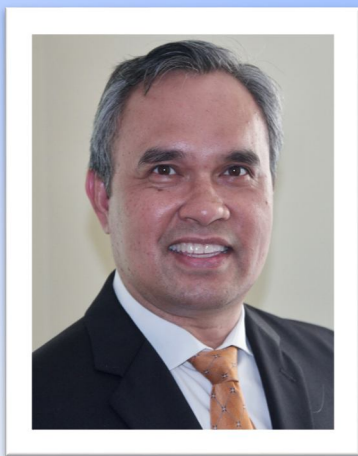

# SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

This Sunday, we celebrate the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. It is one of the most picturesque Catholic feasts. The feast is also known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi. Together with this feast, St. Rose parish also celebrates our own Frank Avenilla's Ordination to the Permanent Diaconate. It is fitting to combine these two celebrations, since the order of deacons serve the body of Christ at the altar and in the ecclesial community through various ministries.

The feast of Corpus Christi celebrates Jesus' real presence in the Holy Eucharist. Since the first generation of the Church, Catholics have believed in the words of Jesus such as "this is my body" and "the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh." Catholics have loved the Eucharist and they found creative ways to express their love in customs associated with Corpus Christi. Parishes celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi in different ways. Some schedule extended periods of adoration as the consecrated bread is exposed on the altar in a ciborium or monstrance. Some other parishes organize processions through the streets or important places in the town. These are ways to make public professions of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament. In these processions, God's people journey with the Lord and proclaim faith in Emmanuel, Jesus Christ, who is truly with us. At St. Rose, we make a short procession through our Church's aisles. We not only keep the Blessed Sacrament in our beautiful tabernacle, but we also become living tabernacles as we consume the body and blood of Christ every Sunday. In this way, we take Christ within us into the world whenever we receive Holy Communion. We receive Christ and become one flesh with him.

After every Mass, our procession and adoration continues as we bring Christ in our poor mortal bodies. All our life can become a liturgy, as St. Paul says in one of his letters. Like the first Christians, we are called to walk with Jesus, to be his witnesses as we live our faith by loving and serving others. Let us revere and adore Christ on the feast of Corpus Christi and process with him outside of our Church into our homes, workplaces, and streets.

Este domingo celebramos la solemnidad del cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo. Tal vez, es una de las fiestas más pintorescas en la iglesia católica. Esta fiesta también es conocida por su nombre en latín, Corpus Cristi. Junto con esta fiesta, la parroquia de Santa Rosa también celebra la ordenación al diaconado permanente de Frank Avenilla. Es conveniente celebrar estas dos fiestas juntas ya que el orden del diaconado permanente fue creado por los apóstoles para servir al cuerpo de Cristo, en el altar y en la comunidad eclesial a través de varios ministerios.



La fiesta de Corpus Cristi celebra la presencia real de Jesús en la eucaristía. Desde la primera generación de cristianos en la iglesia, los católicos han creído fervientemente en las palabras de Jesús como cuando dijo, 'este es mi cuerpo' y 'el pan que yo les daré para la vida del mundo es mi carne'. Católicos han amado la eucaristía y fomentaron varias formas creativas de expresar su amor en las costumbres asociadas con Corpus Cristi. Muchas parroquias celebran esta fiesta de diferentes maneras. Algunas establecen un tiempo prolongado de adoración al santísimo expuesto sobre el altar en una custodia. Otras parroquias organizan procesiones por las calles o lugares concurridos en el pueblo. Estas son algunas formas de hacer pública nuestra profesión de fe y adorar al santísimo sacramento. En estas procesiones, el pueblo de Dios camina con el Señor y proclama la fe en Emanuel, Jesucristo, quien está realmente con nosotros. En nuestra parroquia de Santa Rosa, hacemos una pequeña procesión por los pasillos de nuestra iglesia. Nosotros no solamente guardamos el cuerpo de Cristo en nuestro bello tabernáculo, sino que también nosotros mismos nos convertimos en tabernáculos vivientes cuando consumimos el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo cada domingo. De esta manera, llevamos a Cristo al mundo siempre y cuando recibimos la santa comunión. Recibimos a Cristo y nos hacemos una carne con él.

Después de cada Misa, nuestra procesión y adoración al Señor continua cuando llevamos a Cristo en nuestros cuerpos mortales. Toda nuestra vida puede convertirse en una liturgia como San Pablo lo describe en una de sus cartas. Como los primeros cristianos, estamos llamados a caminar con Jesús, a ser sus testigos cuando vivimos nuestra fe amando y sirviendo a otros. Demos reverencia y adoración a Cristo en la fiesta de Corpus Cristi y salgamos en procesión fuera de la iglesia llevando a Cristo en nuestras casas, lugares de trabajo y por las calles.

### FROM FR. OSCAR



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Many historians see the feast of Corpus Christi as the Church's response to the heretical doctrine of certain wayward theologians who disbelieved Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist. The most notorious of these theologians was Berengarius, a French monk of the eleventh century, who argued that the bread and wine undergo no conversion during the Mass, but that the body and blood of Christ are nonetheless mysteriously present somehow. As such heresies gained ground, faithful Catholics grew more fervent in their opposition, and they pursued more ardently the devotions cast off by the heretics. Pope Urban IV, in the 13<sup>th</sup> century, extended the feast of Corpus Christi to the entire Latin Church. He assigned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the poems and sequence for the liturgy, such as *Panis Angelicus*, *Pange Lingua Gloriosi*, and *O Salutaris Hostia*.

I hope we can all renew our faith in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist as we celebrate Mass this Sunday.
