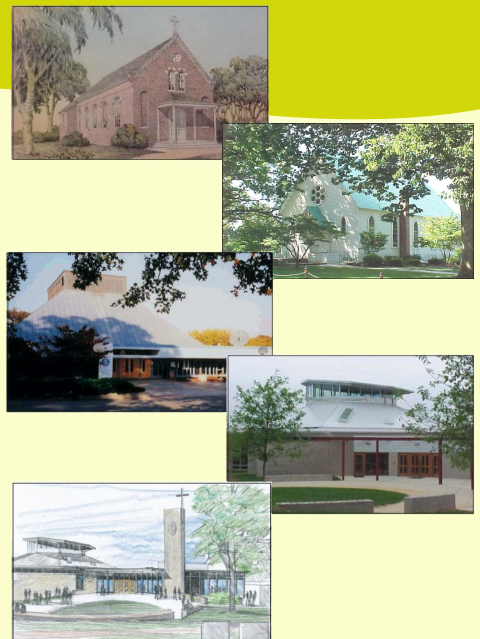

# SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

In today's Gospel, the Lord appointed 72 others whom He sent ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He intended to visit." That means seventy-two people besides the Apostles.

Who were these 72? Where did they come from? What were their names? What happened to them? We don't know because they aren't mentioned anywhere else in the New Testament. Maybe they represent all of us who are called to bring in the harvest along with the apostles.

Also fascinating are the instructions the Lord gives them. The Lord says, "*Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals...*" It's so easy for us to accumulate things. Both as a Church and as individuals we need to simplify our lives. It's so easy to accumulate things, to get enmeshed by them, weighed down by them, almost trapped by them. We all need a yard sale now and then. We can use these instructions from the Lord to call us to simplify our life, maybe by giving away now some of those possessions that we promised others after we die so we can experience their enjoyment and use of them.

We need to simplify our lives materially because that can help us focus on the spiritual goods of honest, faithful friendships, love, faith and family that really make life worth living. There is such a thing as a slavery to things, money and possessions in the hope that they will insure our happiness.

These instructions of the Lord call us to simplify our lives not only materially but spiritually. We can make our spiritual life so complicated and cluttered that we can lose the focus we all need to have on the Cross of Jesus Christ.

These 72 were sent to prepare the places where the Lord would come. That is our mission too. We can become very distracted in trying to do great things for Christ only in the big city and miss the opportunities for witness in the town and places where we live. It is not the drama of great results that will be our salvation. It is the faithfulness of our daily living that prepares the way for Christ.

We all need to simplify our lives materially so we are free to focus on the spiritual goods of friends, family and faith. We all need to simplify our lives spiritually so we can focus on the Cross of Jesus Christ as the true magnetic north of everything we are and do as a Church. We all need to simplify. "the goal of our life on earth so we can focus on the importance of the victory of grace in our soul through daily fidelity."

¿Quiénes eran estos 72? ¿De dónde vinieron? ¿Cómo se llamaban? ¿Qué les pasó? No lo sabemos porque no se mencionan en ningún otro lugar del Nuevo Testamento. Tal vez representen a todos los que estamos llamados a traer la cosecha junto con los apóstoles.

También son fascinantes las instrucciones que el Señor les da. El Señor dice, "No llesves bolsa de dinero, ni saco, ni sandalias..." Es tan fácil para nosotros acumular cosas. Tanto como Iglesia como como individuos, necesitamos simplificar nuestra vida. Es tan fácil acumular cosas, ser enredado por ellas, agobiadas por ellos, casi atrapados por ellos. Todos necesitamos una venta de patio de vez en cuando. Podemos usar estas instrucciones del Señor para llamarnos a simplificar nuestra vida, tal vez regalando ahora algunas de esas posesiones que prometimos a otros después de morir para que podamos experimentar su disfrute y uso de ellas.

Necesitamos simplificar nuestra vida materialmente porque eso puede ayudarnos a centrarnos en los bienes espirituales de amistades honestas y fieles, amor, fe y familia que realmente hacen que la vida valga la pena vivir. Hay algo así como la esclavitud de las cosas, el dinero y las posesiones con la esperanza de que aseguren nuestra felicidad.

Estas instrucciones del Señor nos llaman a simplificar nuestra vida no sólo material sino espiritualmente. Podemos hacer que nuestra vida espiritual sea tan complicada y desordenada que podamos perder el enfoque que todos necesitamos tener en la Cruz de Jesucristo.

Esos 72 fueron enviados para preparar los lugares donde el Señor vendría. Esa es nuestra misión también. Podemos distraernos mucho al tratar de hacer grandes cosas por Cristo sólo en la gran ciudad y perder las oportunidades de ser testigos en la ciudad y los lugares donde vivimos. No es el drama de grandes resultados que será nuestra salvación. Es la fidelidad de nuestra vida diaria la que prepara el camino para Cristo.

Todos necesitamos simplificar nuestra vida materialmente para que seamos libres de centrarnos en los bienes espirituales de los amigos, la familia y la fe. Todos necesitamos simplificar nuestra vida espiritualmente para poder centrarnos en la Cruz de Jesucristo como el verdadero norte magnético de todo lo que somos y hacemos como Iglesia. Todos necesitamos simplificar. "la meta de nuestra vida en la tierra para que podamos centrarnos en la importancia de la victoria de la gracia en nuestra alma a través de la fidelidad diaria."

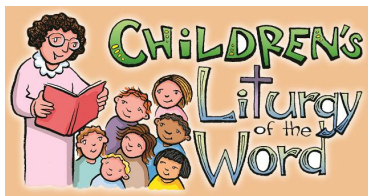
