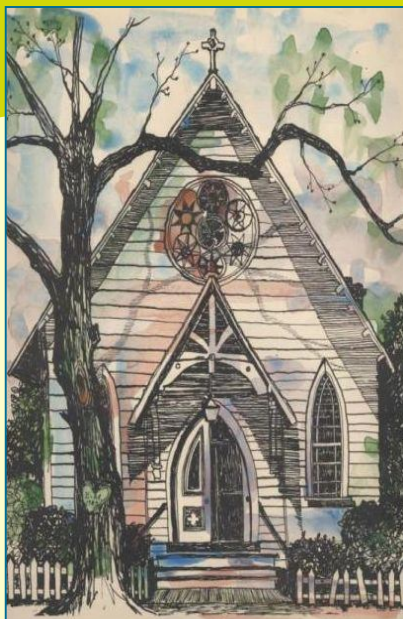

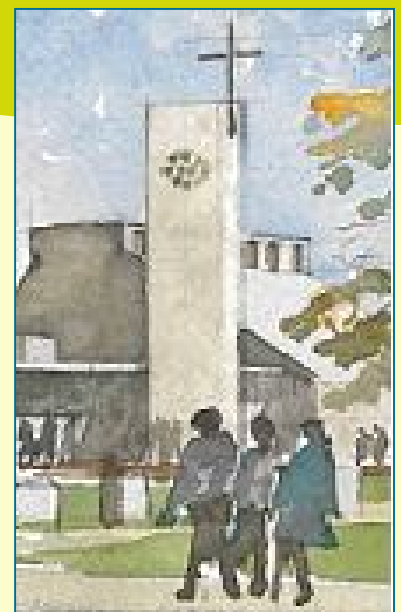

# SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

This Sunday we hear about the story of Mary and Martha hosting Jesus at their house. These two women taught us the qualities of discipleship. Mary taught us the intimate listening and talking to Jesus in prayer. Martha taught us the external works of charity with our brothers and sisters. Prayer is the foundational attitude for any external charitable activity. The external works of mercy and charity are the result of choosing the best part of having a dialogue and relationship with Jesus at his feet. The intimate dialogue with God through prayer leads us to serve others.

The contemplative life and works of charity in the Church go by the hands. The contemplative life with Christ in prayer and adoration is the cause for the external works of charity with our brothers and sisters. Prayer is the cause, while charity is the effect. They always go together, and in this order. This gospel reminds us of the Benedictine rule, "ora et labora," pray and work. This is what the monks used to do in their cells. We can also speak in terms of faith and charitable work. Martha was right in serving the Lord with all her good intention. But it seems that she had a hard time understanding what Mary was doing at the feet of Jesus. Mary had the foundation of discipleship, which is an intimate relationship with God, speaking and listening to him. Mary was not lazy, since to pray to God is not what lazy people do. Often we hear of people neglecting prayer because of laziness. Prayer is hard work sometimes, because our life may be full of activities that do not create a space for reflection and contemplation. Many people may perform good works of charity, but sometimes they may not have the foundation necessary to sustain them. Nowadays, this risk of doing works of charity without a spiritual foundation or direction may be called "activism." Instead, some people may have few works of charity, but with a strong spiritual foundation in Christ. These people follow Christ on solid ground, for they have the most important part of discipleship, which is interior faith. Faith can lead us to many works of charity, even when we are unable to fulfill them. This is the example of many missionary saints whose work may have been very insignificant, yet their holiness of life was so significant that it enriched the whole Church. For instance, St. Therese of the Child Jesus died at the young age of twenty-four in a Carmelite convent. Her works of charity were little and few, yet she became a doctor of the Church for her immense supernatural love that she put into the little things she did in the convent. Many of her works were even hidden during her life and were later acknowledged after her death. These people of faith were truly disciples to be at the feet of Jesus, yet serving him in small acts of charity. Instead, we would be hesitant to affirm that a disciple of Christ should have many good works, but not relationship with Christ.

Let us learn discipleship from both Martha and Mary together in today's gospel reading. They are two indispensable aspects of discipleship. However, the attitude of Mary is the source and foundation for the work of Martha.

Este domingo escuchamos sobre el episodio cuando Marta y María acogieron a Jesús en su casa. Estas dos mujeres nos enseñaron las cualidades de un discípulo de Jesús. María nos enseña que necesitamos una íntima relación a los pies de Jesús, escuchando y hablándolo en la oración. Mientras que Marta nos enseña que también es necesario el servicio caritativo con los hermanos que nos rodean. Estos dos aspectos de la vida de María y Marta son indispensables para un discípulo. Solo que la actitud de María es la base de la actitud de Marta. La oración debe ser el motor de todas nuestras actividades caritativas. Las actividades caritativas son el efecto de elegir la mejor parte de María a los pies de Jesús. El diálogo íntimo que podemos tener con nuestro Señor puede llevarnos a servir a los demás.

La vida contemplativa y los trabajos caritativos en la iglesia van de la mano. La vida contemplativa con Cristo en la oración y adoración es la causa primaria de los trabajos externos que podemos llevar a cabo con nuestro prójimo. La oración es la causa mientras que la caridad es el efecto de la oración. Estos dos aspectos siempre van juntos y en ese orden. Este evangelio nos recuerda la regla benedictina que dice 'ora et labora', que quiere decir 'ora y trabaja'. Esto es lo que los monjes hacían en sus celdas. Podemos hablar también en términos de fe y caridad con los que necesitan de nosotros. Marta hacía lo correcto en servir al Señor en su casa, pero parecía que no podía entender lo que hacía María a los pies de Jesús. María tenía la base que todo discípulo necesita, que es una relación íntima con Dios hablando y escuchándolo a sus pies. María no padecía de pereza, ya que orar a Dios no es lo que la gente perezosa hace. Muchas veces gente omite rezar por pereza. La oración es un arduo trabajo a veces porque nuestra vida puede estar llena de actividades que impiden crear un espacio de reflexión y contemplación. Muchas personas pueden llevar a cabo muchas actividades caritativas, pero a veces estas actividades pueden no estar construidas sobre una base sólida para sostenerlas. Hoy en día, este riesgo de hacer trabajos caritativos sin una base o dirección espiritual puede ser llamado 'activismo'. En cambio, algunas personas pueden hacer pocos trabajos de caridad, pero con una fuerte base espiritual en Cristo. Este segundo grupo de personas siguen al Señor por un camino más firme porque poseen lo más importante de la vida de un discípulo, que es la fe de corazón. La fe nos puede llevar a hacer muchos trabajos caritativos, hasta cuando no somos capaces de cumplirlos físicamente por algún motivo. Este es el ejemplo de muchos santos misioneros de quienes sus trabajos tal vez fueron insignificantes, pero su santidad de vida fue tan significativa que enriquecieron a toda la iglesia. Por ejemplo, Santa Teresa de Jesús murió a la edad de veinticuatro años en un convento Carmelita. Sus trabajos de caridad fueron pocos y pequeños ya que pasó muchos años de su vida enferma, pero llegó a ser una doctora de la Iglesia por su inmenso amor sobrenatural con que amó con fe de corazón a sus hermanas en el convento. Puso un montón de amor en las pequeñas obras de caridad en el convento. Muchos de sus trabajos fueron incluso ocultos durante su vida y fueron luego reconocidos después de su muerte. Esta clase de santos fueron realmente discípulos con fe para estar a los pies del Señor y al mismo tiempo servirles con pequeños actos de caridad. En cambio, no podríamos afirmar que un discípulo de Cristo tiene muchos trabajos de caridad, pero nada de relación con Cristo en la fe.

Aprendamos los aspectos de un discípulo de Cristo con las mujeres Marta y María en el evangelio de hoy. Ellas son dos aspectos indispensables de un discípulo. Pero, tengamos también en cuenta que la actitud de María siempre es la fuente y base del trabajo caritativo que Marta y todos nosotros podemos llevar a cabo.
