My dear Parishioners,

As you may already know, Molly Herrera, our beloved Coordinator of Youth Ministry and Young Adult Faith Formation, after prayer and consideration has accepted a position as Program Director of Campus and Young Adult Ministry with the Archdiocese of Washington. We will miss her professional skills, ever-present smile and compassionate care for the young and their families. While saying goodbye is hard, we can be certain that the gifts she has shared with us will continue to enliven the faith of many others now at an Archdiocesan level. A brief expression of gratitude only skims the surface of the impact she made here at Saint Rose of Lima Church for the past few years of ministerial service.

Last March the Holy Father published the post-synodal apostolic exhortation to young people and the entire people of God, "**Christus Vivit,**" **Christ is Alive**. I am proud to share that Molly has led our parish toward embracing many of these aspects, helping us to recognize the importance of the young church. While there are many themes in this exhortation, I want to focus on five.

The *holiness of the young* has been the foundation of Molly's ministry. She listened and encouraged those navigating their way through understanding God, themselves, and the community. Her ministry empowered peer leaders, youth and young adults, to serve as witnesses to Christ on retreats, service projects, and catechetical sessions. Molly gently reminded both staff and parishioners of the holiness of our young people that we sometimes missed.


The *journey of accompaniment* was a key initiative that Molly embraced. She invested in training and supporting adult leaders to serve as catechists, mentors, retreat team members, service project leaders, and more. Molly worked hard to invite adult leaders to value the importance of accompaniment, so that young people knew that their presence and their lives mattered.

The *Gospel message* was consistently and creatively shared with young people and their families. Whether they attended MoHO, Confirmation parent sessions, young adult small faith groups, or adult leader trainings - in each gathering prayer and engaging examples about living as a missionary disciple were grounded in the communal celebration of the sacraments. Molly pointed to God's love for others over and over, through words, actions, and prayer.

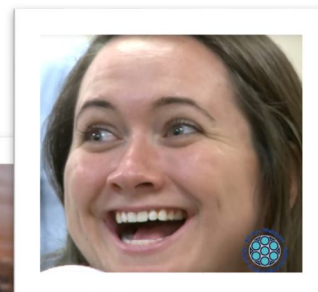
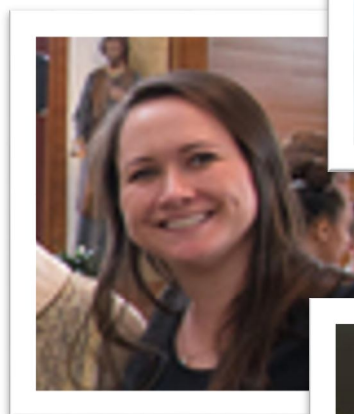
The *call to leadership* was particularly important. As a young person herself, Molly provided an example to our parish of the many gifts that young people offer the Church. She inspired others to consider sharing their gifts too. More importantly, she followed up with those young people by extending invitations to get involved in a wide variety of parish ministries, which truly embraced a comprehensive, parish-wide approach.

Finally, Molly has been an example of what it means to accept the *invitation to discern* God's call. When she interviewed for her current position five years ago, she took time to pray and consult the wisdom of others rather than immediately accepting the job offer. She has consistently sought God's will and is open to follow wherever the Lord leads, even when that demands change.

We promise our prayers for her and her family as this new transition takes place. Together, we give thanks to God for the gift of Molly.

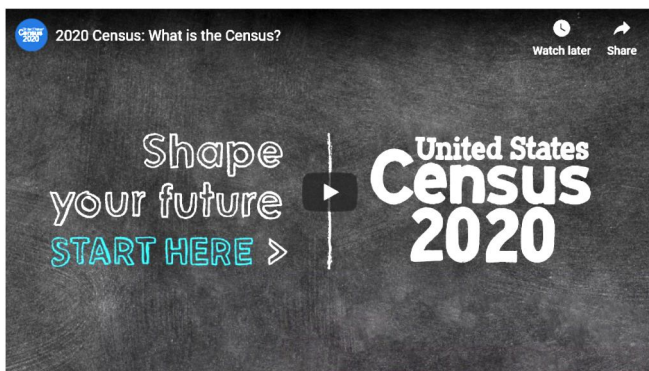

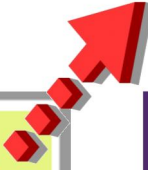
