SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

This Sunday we hear about the famous encounter between the Samaritan woman and Jesus at the well. Jesus, an observant Jew of that time, was expected to avoid conversations with unclean women in public. Instead, Jesus not only converses with the woman, but he also asks to share her drinking vessel, an action that makes him unclean according to Jewish law.

The women of the town would have traveled to the well in the early morning, but this Samaritan woman came at noon, the hottest time of the day. The timing of her visit, being Samaritan, and with many husbands, are clear signs that this woman was an outcast. We can see the significance of the encounter on three levels. First, the woman personally believes in Jesus as the Messiah. He knows her sin, she acknowledges her sin, and the woman finds in Jesus the source of life, the living waters for eternal life. Second, having come to believe in Jesus as the Messiah, the Samaritan woman becomes an evangelizer to her own town. Third, Jesus uses his encounter with the woman to teach his disciples that God's love and mercy is also for the outcast. Jesus came to encounter and to quench the thirst of those who are lost and looking for life, for love, for the idols of the world, to fill their empty lives. The woman may have had many lovers, but not true love. The woman is a symbol of many of us, searching for life in the things or activities that cannot quench our thirst for life. The woman found the Messiah to lead her towards the waters of eternal life.

This coming Saturday, Archbishop Wilton Gregory will visit our parish of St. Rose of Lima. He is our shepherd who, like Jesus, would like to meet his flock, bless our new stained glass windows, and witness the different ministries that enrich our parish. Archbishop Wilton Gregory was born December 7, 1947 in Chicago. He attended St. Carthage Grammar School, where he converted to Catholicism. He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago on May 9, 1973. In 1994, he was appointed to serve as the bishop of the Diocese of Belleville, Illinois, for eleven years. Then, in 2004, St. John Paul II appointed him as bishop of Atlanta, where he served for fifteen years. Pope Francis appointed him as Archbishop of Washington on April 4, 2019. Archbishop Gregory was installed as our shepherd on May 21, 2019. Let us give a loving and warm welcome to our shepherd who comes to meet and to bless us.



Este domingo escuchamos del conocido encuentro entre la mujer samaritana y Jesús frente al pozo de Jacob. Se esperaba que Jesús, un judío practicante de la época, evitara las conversaciones con mujeres impuras en público. En cambio,

Jesús no solo conversa con la mujer, sino que también le pide que comparta su cántaro de agua para beber, una acción que lo haría impuro a Jesús de acuerdo con la ley judía.

Las mujeres de la ciudad seguramente iban al pozo temprano en la mañana, pero esta mujer samaritana llegó al mediodía, el momento más caluroso del día. La hora de su visita, ser samaritana y con muchos maridos son claros signos de que esta mujer era una pagana. Podemos ver la importancia del encuentro en tres niveles. Primero, la mujer cree personalmente en Jesús como el Mesías. Él conoce su pecado, ella reconoce su pecado, y la mujer encuentra en Jesús la fuente de la vida, el camino hacia las aguas de la vida eterna. Segundo, habiendo llegado a

creer en Jesús como el Mesías, la mujer samaritana se convierte en evangelizadora de su propio pueblo. Tercero, Jesús usa su encuentro con la mujer para enseñar a sus discípulos que el amor y la misericordia de Dios también es para los paganos. Jesús vino al encuentro y a saciar la sed de aquellos que están perdidos y que buscan la vida, el amor, los ídolos del mundo para llenar sus vidas vacías. La mujer pudo haber tenido muchos amantes, pero no el verdadero amor. La mujer es un símbolo de muchos de nosotros buscando vida en las cosas o actividades que no pueden saciar nuestra sed de vida. La mujer encontró al Mesías para guiarla hacia las aguas de la vida eterna.

El próximo sábado, tendremos la visita de nuestro Arzobispo Wilton Gregory a nuestra parroquia de Santa Rosa de Lima. Él es nuestro pastor que, como Jesús, quisiera encontrarse con su rebaño, bendecir nuestras nuevas vidrieras y presenciar los diferentes ministerios que enriquecen nuestra parroquia. El arzobispo Wilton Gregory nació el 7 de diciembre de 1947 en Chicago. Asistió a St. Carthage Grammar School, donde se convirtió al catolicismo. Fue ordenado sacerdote de la Arquidiócesis de Chicago el 9 de mayo de 1973. En 1994, fue nombrado obispo de la Diócesis de Belleville, Illinois, donde sirvió por once años. Luego, en 2004, San Juan Pablo II lo nombró obispo de Atlanta, donde sirvió durante quince años. El Papa Francisco lo nombró Arzobispo de Washington el 4 de abril de 2019. El Arzobispo Gregory fue instalado como nuestro pastor el 21 de mayo de 2019. Demos una cálida bienvenida a nuestro pastor que viene a conocernos y bendecirnos.

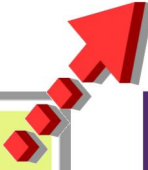
