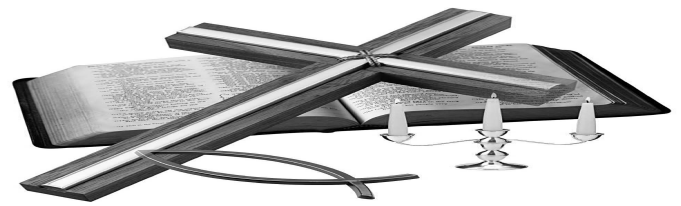

Moments of farewell remind us of limits: of time exhausted, distances reached (or beyond our reach), the start of absence instead of presence.

After almost three years as Administrator and more than 90 months living, praying, and working at the

Church of Saint Joseph in Yonkers, our time together ends in a matter of days. **With gratitude to Almighty God** for His call to the sacred priesthood, the Blessed Virgin Mary, my patron saints and guardian angel for their intercession, and so many of you for your patient love and support, I ask your prayers as I leave for Florida to be present to my aging parents and their needs. To that end, **I thank His Eminence, Timothy Cardinal Dolan, D.D., our Archbishop** for his gracious encouragement at this time as well as for entrusting to me in August 2013 your souls and the spiritual and temporal goods of our parish. **Know that I have thrown myself into giving you the care and love of a father:** to provide, to protect, to lead, to encourage, to correct, to bless, to teach, to accompany, to console, all towards—I pray—to holiness.

Along the way, God has blessed me with the saintly, veteran presence of **Dcn. Abraham Santiago**, the patriarch of our parish, a loyal and caring Rectory staff (**Anita Gardella, Baldomero Moran, and Carmen Ureña**, along with some splendid volunteers), **William “Frank” Dietrich**, our savvy Cemetery Superintendent, **a thoughtful Pastoral Council and concerned Trustees, Iris Flores, D.R.E.**, and so many parishioners from both Mass communities (without forgetting friends, benefactors and allies from other parishes and communities). I hope that these blessings will be extended to **Fr. Joe Francis**, the priest who will succeed me in charge of our parish, **and I urge you all to welcome him when he comes in mid-July.** We also may get a transitional deacon to supplement our venerable Deacon Santiago too! Please greet **Msgr. Kevin O’Brien and Fr. Roberto Pérez, O.Carm.** as they offer holy Mass in the meantime at our parish.

Space does not suffice to review the challenges faced, especially at the start, and the riches released to our parish from the talents and time of so many people just awaiting the opportunity and encouragement. Truly, our parish has become a place where the axiom, **lex orandi, lex credendi** (“*We pray what we believe; we believe what we pray*” from Latin) is **lived, sung, and extended** through works of charity and advocacy of the good, the true, and the beautiful. **With your help** for our clerics, lay ministers (lectors, extraordinary ministers of holy communion, altar boys, sacristans, choirs, ushers), and among the bilingual family of the Church of Saint Joseph, **our example of faith and good works will continue for as long as God sees fit.**
