St Martin of Tours, November 11th

Martin, who became one of the most popular saints in medieval Europe, was born in the year 316 in Savaria, now in Hungary. Already at an early age he had a desire to become a Christian and began receiving instruction as a catechumen. At the age of 15 he joined the Roman cavalry and was stationed near the city of Amiens, France.

It is at this period of his life that occurred the event for which he is best known and which became a favorite subject for artists. On seeing an almost naked beggar at Amiens, he cut his own cloak in two and gave one part to the beggar. This act of charity was followed that night by a dream in which Christ appeared to him wearing the part of the cloak he had given away - and said to him, 'Martin has clothed me with his own cloak'.

The dream confirmed Martin in his Christian leanings and he was baptized at the age of 18. After this Martin became a solitary hermit and some disciples joined him and formed what was the first monastery in France. Martin remained a pioneer of the monastic movement until he was made the bishop of Tours in 372 by the popular demand of the clergy and the people.

Even as a bishop he continued to lead the life of a monk, at first in a cell near his cathedral church and later in Marmoutier, where he founded a monastery, and which soon numbered 80 monks, leading a life of great austerity. He also established other monasteries which he saw as an effective means for one of his objectives, the conversion of rural areas.

As Martin grew older and death was approaching, his people asked him not to leave them. As a response to their plea he prayed: 'Lord, if your people still need me I do not refuse the work; let your will be done.' He died on November 8th, 397 aged 81 at Candes and was buried at Tours on 11th November - 1619 years ago. His cult spread rapidly and his tomb in Tours became a major center of pilgrimage, and was a famous stopping-point for pilgrims on the road to Santiago de Compostela, Spain.

In Christian art he is normally shown as dividing his cloak to clothe a beggar. He is the patron saint of France and the first great leader of Western monasticism.

San Martin de Tours, 11 de noviembre

En el año 316, en un puesto fronterizo, todavía reinando Constantino, en la entonces llamada Panonia, en Sabaria, hoy Hungría, hijo de un tribuno llegado a tal desde el llano - de soldado raso, a lo mejor bárbaro de nacimiento- nace un tal Martín. Se ve que este tribuno húngaro, su padre, desempeñó un papel militar notable en estas luchas fronterizas. A los dieciséis años, como era de rigor entre los ciudadanos, después de haber recibido esmerada educación, ingresó en el arma de caballería.

Parece ser, en los comienzos de su carrera, siendo jefe de patrulla en la ciudad de Amiens, al norte de París -donde hoy se levanta la catedral gótica más grande de Europa-, es cuando sucede el famoso pasaje de su encuentro, a las puertas de la ciudad, con un mendigo casi muerto de frío a quien -cortándola de un solo tajo de su filosa espada-, cubre con la mitad de la clámide regalada por su madre. Esa noche sueña, según Sulpicio Severo, con Jesús, cubiertos sus divinos hombros con su capa.

Se bautizará meses después continuando su carrera de soldado. Primero en la caballería de la guardia imperial, bajo Constanzo, que había logrado unificar nuevamente el imperio. . En el año 355 pasaba a los órdenes de Juliano, nombrado César por su tío Constanzo. Lo sigue en sus exitosas campañas renanas. Finalmente después de 25 años de cuarteles, campamentos y batallas, deja el servicio, quizá asqueado cuando, en el 360, las tropas aclaman a Juliano emperador, en rebeldía contra Constanzo. Ya eran muchos años de trinchera y de cargas de caballería. En realidad, normalmente, para un romano, hora de comenzar la carrera de los honores civiles.

Pero Martín elige, más bien, ingresar en la milicia de otro emperador: Cristo. ('*Christianus es*'). Su vida desde entonces estará dedicada a la Iglesia. Se pone al servicio de San Hilario de Poitiers a quien acompaña en su destierro a Frigia. En Poitiers, funda lo que será el primer monasterio de Europa. Hilario, que ha vuelto del destierro, lo nombra primero diácono y luego sacerdote. Martín, con los suyos, se dedica a predicar en los campos, en los llamados 'pagos', a donde aún no había llegado el cristianismo -de allí el término 'pagano'- . También con Hilario ha de combatir vigorosamente la herejía arriana. Pero no será un obispo más: funda un centro monástico a poca distancia de Tours, en la orilla derecha del Loira, en Marmoutier, donde vive retirado y en oración todo el tiempo que su cargo le deja libre. "Y así concibió su vida cristiana y episcopal: con estrategia y valentía de guerrero. Y, si como oficial del emperador terreno fue bueno, como general del Señor del universo fue mil veces mejor. La muerte lo sorprendió el ocho de noviembre del año 397 en la aldea de Candes, a orillas del Loira, donde había arribado liderando su enésima campaña de pacificador y conquistador de almas. Martín es el primer santo no mártir que figuró en un mosaico. Sus representaciones, siempre de soldado cortando su capa con su espada y entregándola al pobre, son millares en todo el mundo.
