Our Lady of Mount Carmel (July 16th)

This is the patronal feast of the Carmelite Order. The origin of the 'Order of Our Lady of Mount Carmel' is obscure, but it grew from a community of European hermits who settled on Mt Carmel, near Haifa in Israel overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. Mount Carmel was the scene of Elijah's struggle with the priests of Baal 3,000 years ago when he prayed for rain and called down fire from heaven.

In 1156, some crusaders settled on Mt Carmel and a group of about 11 brethren established a society of hermits, calling themselves the 'Brothers of Our Lady of Mt Carmel'.

According to pious tradition, the Virgin appeared to St Simon Stock in Cambridge, England, on July 16, 1251, and gave him the scapular - a brown habit with ankle length portions front and back. St Simon Stock is considered the Father of the Carmelite Order.

Our Lady promised that whoever wore this habit faithfully until death as a sign of dedication to her would not suffer eternal damnation. There is no historical evidence for this alleged apparition until 1642, when a pamphlet encouraging the wearing of the scapular was circulated.

Any reference to the scapular before the 16th century always meant the large monastic scapular, and not the small pieces of cloth with which we are now familiar. But the popularity of the little brown scapular cannot be denied. Like any sacramental, it fosters holiness of life. If a person perseveres in devotion to Mary as the model of all sanctity, one most certainly will not suffer eternal punishment.

This sacramental is a sign of affiliation to the Carmelite Order and a symbol of Our Lady's desire to bring us all to Jesus. The message of the Scapular is the same advice she gave the servants at the Cana wedding: 'Do whatever he tells you'. When we wear the Scapular, it is a sign of our loving response to the Mother of God. So, in our special devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, we celebrate our unique relationship with Mary as an intrinsic part of our spirituality.

St Teresa of Avila called Carmel 'the Order of the Virgin'. St John of the Cross credited Mary with saving him from drowning as a child, leading him to Carmel and helping him escape from prison. Both the Carmelite friars and the nuns take as their inspiration the Blessed Virgin Mary, the fiery prophet Elijah, and saints like Teresa of Avila and John of the Cross.

For centuries the Carmelites have seen themselves as specially related to Mary. Their great saints and theologians have promoted devotion to her and often championed the mystery of her Immaculate Conception.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel, pray for us!

Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo (16 de Julio)

Esta es la fiesta patronal de la Orden Carmelita. El origen de la 'Orden de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo' es oscuro, pero surgió de una comunidad de ermitaños europeos que se asentaron en el Monte Carmelo, cerca de Haifa en Israel con vista al Mar Mediterráneo. El Monte Carmelo fue el escenario de la lucha del Profeta Elías con los sacerdotes de Baal hace 3,000 atrás cuando oró pidiendo lluvia y que viniera fuego desde cielo.

En 1156, algunos cruzados se establecieron en el Monte Carmelo y un grupo de unos 11 hermanos establecieron una sociedad de ermitaños, llamándose a sí mismos "Hermanos de Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo".

Según la tradición piadosa, la Virgen se apareció a San Simón Stock en Cambridge, Inglaterra, el 16 de julio, 1251, y le dio el escapulario - un hábito marrón con longitud hasta el tobillo por adelante y por atrás. San Simón Stock es considerado el padre de la Orden Carmelita. La Virgen le prometió que quien llevara el escapulario fielmente hasta la muerte como signo de dedicación a ella no sufriría la condenación eterna. No hay evidencia histórica de esta supuesta aparición hasta 1642, cuando circuló un panfleto que alentaba el uso del escapulario.

Cualquier referencia al escapulario antes del siglo XVI, siempre significaba el gran escapulario monástico y no las pequeñas piezas de tela con las que ahora estamos familiarizados. Pero la popularidad del pequeño escapulario marrón no puede ser negada. Como todo sacramental, fomenta la santidad de la vida. Si una persona persevera en la devoción a María como modelo de toda santidad, uno seguramente no sufrirá el castigo eterno.

Este sacramental es un signo de afiliación a la Orden Carmelita y un símbolo del deseo de Nuestra Señora de llevarnos a todos a Jesús. El mensaje del Escapulario es el mismo consejo que dio a los sirvientes en la boda de Cana: "Hagan lo que él les diga". Cuando usamos el Escapulario, es un signo de nuestra respuesta amorosa a la Madre de Dios. Entonces, en nuestra especial devoción a Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo, celebramos nuestra relación única con María como parte intrínseca de nuestra espiritualidad.

Santa Teresa de Ávila llamó al Carmelo, "la Orden de la Virgen". San Juan de la Cruz le acredita a María de evitar que se ahogara cuando era niño, de llevarlo al Carmelo y de ayudarlo a escapar de la prisión. Tanto los frailes como las monjas Carmelitas toman como inspiración a la Santísima Virgen María, al ardiente profeta Elías y a santos como Teresa de Ávila y Juan de la Cruz.

Durante siglos los carmelitas se han visto especialmente relacionados con María. Sus grandes santos y teólogos han promovido la devoción a ella y a menudo han defendido el misterio de su Inmaculada Concepción.

Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo, ruega por nosotros!
