St Ignatius of Loyola - July 31st

Ignatius of Loyola was the youngest of eleven children of a Basque nobleman. He was brought up to be a soldier. During a battle with the French in Pamplona a cannon ball shattered his leg. His leg was badly set by the doctors, was broken again and reset. This bad surgery, left him deformed, and he walked with a limp for the rest of his life.

During his convalescence, he asked to read romance novels, but the hospital had none. Instead, he was given two spiritual books – a Life of Christ and a Life of the Saints. That did it! His conscience was deeply touched, and a long, painful conversion began.

Having seen the Mother of God in a vision, he made a pilgrimage to her shrine at Montserrat near Barcelona. He remained for almost a year at nearby Manresa, sometimes with the Dominicans and sometimes in a cave in the hills, praying. He experienced both desolation and consolation. It was during this year of conversion that he began to write the first draft of his greatest work - Spiritual Exercises.

In 1523 he kept a resolution to go to the Holy Land but could not stay because of the hostility of the Muslims. So, he returned to Spain, without a clear plan for his life.

He decided to study Latin, in order to work for souls. His eagerness to gain an education, took him to Paris where he studied philosophy for three years and became a Master of Arts.

In Paris he gathered six disciples to whom he gave the Spiritual Exercises. One of those was St Francis Xavier. They vowed to live in poverty and chastity and to go to the Holy Land. If this became impossible, they vowed to offer themselves to the apostolic service of the Holy Father.

In 1540, Ignatius made the association permanent. The new Society of Jesus was approved by Pope Paul III, and Ignatius was elected to serve as the first general. For the rest of his life he stayed at Rome, directing the Society he had founded.

Ignatius was a true mystic. His spirituality is expressed in the Jesuit motto, Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam - for the greater glory of God. All activity was to be guided by a true love of the Church and unconditional obedience to the Holy Father, for which reason all professed members took a fourth vow to go wherever the pope should send them for the salvation of souls. He died in Rome on July 31st, 1556 at the age of 65.

The Jesuits became the greatest force in the Catholic Counter-Reformation. They were also very prominent in the foreign missions. The pioneer work of Francis Xavier in India and the Far East was emulated by others later in China, South America, USA and Canada.

They have had a tremendous influence on politics and education throughout the world. It all began with a setback, a crisis - a leg shattered by a cannonball. Let us always see crises as occasions of grace.

San Ignacio de Loyola - 31 de julio

Ignacio de Loyola era el menor de once hijos de un noble vasco. Fue criado para ser soldado. Durante una batalla con los franceses en Pamplona, una bala de cañón le destruyó la pierna. Los doctores le pusieron una pierna mal por lo cual se la volvieron a quebrar y a encajar. Esta mala cirugía lo dejó deformado y caminó cojeando por el resto de su vida.

Durante su convalecencia, pidió leer novelas románticas, pero el hospital no tenía ninguna. En cambio, le dieron dos libros espirituales – uno era La Vida de Cristo y otro La Vida de los Santos. ¡Eso lo logró! Su conciencia quedó profundamente conmovida y tocada, y comenzó una larga y dolorosa conversión.

Habiendo visto a la Madre de Dios en una visión, hizo una peregrinación a su santuario en Montserrat, cerca de Barcelona. Permaneció durante casi un año en la cercana Manresa, a veces con los dominicos y otras en una cueva en las colinas, orando. Experimentó tanto desolación como consuelo. Fue durante este año de conversión que comenzó a escribir el primer borrador de su obra más grande: Ejercicios Espirituales.

En 1523 mantuvo una resolución de ir a Tierra Santa, pero no pudo quedarse debido a la hostilidad de los musulmanes. Entonces regresó a España, sin un plan claro para su vida.

Decidió estudiar latín para trabajar por las almas. Su afán de obtener una educación lo llevó a París, donde estudió filosofía durante tres años y se convirtió en un master de las artes.

En París reunió a seis discípulos a quienes les dio los Ejercicios Espirituales. Uno de ellos fue San Francisco Javier. Juraron vivir en la pobreza y la castidad e ir a Tierra Santa. Si esto se volviera imposible, prometieron ofrecerse al servicio apostólico del Santo Padre.

En 1540, Ignacio hizo permanente la compañía. La nueva Compañía de Jesús fue aprobada por el Papa Pablo III, e Ignacio fue elegido para servir como el primer general. Durante el resto de su vida permaneció en Roma, dirigiendo la Compañía que había fundado.

Ignacio era un verdadero místico. Su espiritualidad se expresa en el lema de los jesuitas, Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam - para la mayor gloria de Dios. Toda actividad debía ser guiada por un verdadero amor a la Iglesia y una obediencia incondicional al Santo Padre, por lo que todos los miembros profesos hacían un cuarto voto para ir a donde el Papa los enviara para la salvación de las almas. Murió en Roma el 31 de julio de 1556 a la edad de 65 años.

Los jesuitas se convirtieron en la mayor fuerza en la Contrarreforma católica. También fueron muy prominentes en las misiones extranjeras. El trabajo pionero de Francisco Javier en India y el Lejano Oriente fue emulado por otros más tarde en China, América del Sur, Estados Unidos y Canadá.

Han tenido una tremenda influencia en la política y la educación en todo el mundo. Todo comenzó con un revés, una crisis - una pierna destruida por una bala de cañón. Veamos siempre las crisis como ocasiones de gracia.

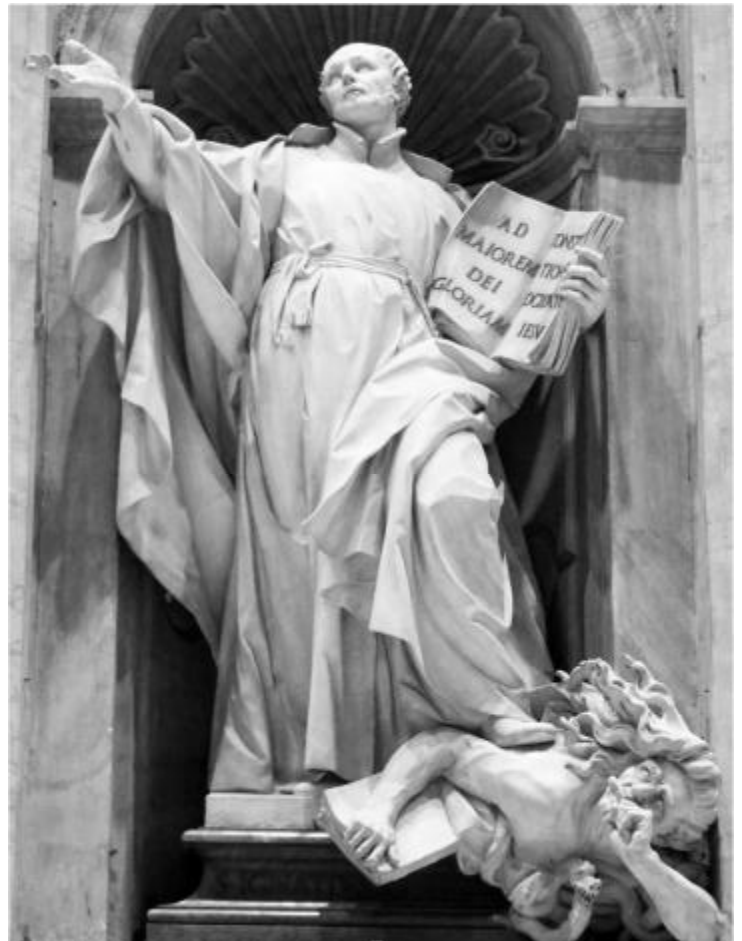
