Pope St Gregory the Great (Sept 3rd)

Pope St Gregory I, commonly known as St Gregory the Great, is one of the most fascinating of early Church leaders. Son of a Roman Senator, Gregory was born in Rome around 540 AD and, following his dad's footsteps, decided upon a political career. He rose through the ranks of civil service and eventually became Prefect of the city of Rome - though he was only about 30 years old. The office of the Prefect was a combination of mayor and chief magistrate.

At that point, Gregory discerned a call to a deeper life with God. So, he promptly gave away his wealth to the poor. Then he turned his house in Rome into a monastery, calling it the Monastery of St Andrew. Eventually he became the abbot.

Upon the death of the pope in 590, Gregory was unanimously acclaimed pope by the clergy and people of - the first monk ever elected as the Successor of Peter. He was about 50 years old at the time.

This man who wanted nothing more but to be a simple monk had to undergo a profound interior struggle before accepting this election as the will of God. As pope, Gregory still lived with great monastic simplicity and austerity.

He immediately set to work, putting in order, the affairs of a Church and society in chaos.

He took over civic as well as spiritual leadership of Italy, appointing governors of the various Italian cities. He who had spent his own wealth to relieve the suffering of the poor, did much the same with the resources of the church. He took the initiative in evangelization, sending Benedictine monks from his former monastery of St Andrews to convert the people of Britain. He chose Augustine who was the prior to be the leader of this venture. He is now known as St Augustine of Canterbury and is considered the Apostle to the English.

Pope Gregory's zeal extended over the entire known world. Many of his writings have survived. He regarded preaching as the indispensable function of every pastor. His great zeal for the glory of God, moved him to reform church music. Gregorian chant /music, which is still recommended by the church for liturgy is named after him.

Besides his mother, two of Gregory's aunts have been canonized - Sts Tarsilla and Æmiliana. Because of this, one of the early biographers of Pope Gregory speaks of his education as being that of a saint among saints.

Called the Great, Gregory has been given a place with Augustine, Ambrose and Jerome as one of the four key Doctors of the Latin Church.

It is significant of St Gregory's concept of religious authority that he called himself the Servant of the servants of God. It is a designation used by the popes ever since.

He died on March 12th, in the year 604. He was Pope for 14 years. He is the patron saint of teachers.

San Gregorio Magno, Papa (3 de septiembre)

El Papa San Gregorio Primero, comúnmente conocido como San Gregorio Magno, es uno de los líderes más fascinantes de la Iglesia Primitiva. Hijo de un senador romano, Gregorio nació en Roma, alrededor del año 540 d.C., y siguiendo los pasos de su padre, se decidió por una carrera política. Ascendió a través de los rangos del servicio civil y eventualmente se convirtió en Prefecto de la ciudad de Roma - aunque solo tenía unos 30 años. La oficina del Prefecto era una combinación de alcalde y jefe magistrado.

En ese punto, Gregorio discernió un llamado a una vida con mayor profundidad con Dios. Así que con prontitud regaló su riqueza a los pobres. Luego convirtió su casa en Roma en un monasterio, llamándolo Monasterio de San Andrés. Eventualmente, se convirtió en abad.

Tras la muerte del papa en el año 590, Gregorio fue aclamado por unanimidad por el clero y el pueblo de Roma para sucederlo - fue el primer monje que jamás se haya elegido sucesor de Pedro. Tenía unos 50 años en ese momento.

Este hombre que no quería nada más que ser un simple monje tuvo que padecer una profunda lucha interior antes de aceptar esta elección como la voluntad de Dios. Como papa, Gregorio aún vivía con gran sencillez monástica y austeridad.

Inmediatamente se puso a trabajar, poniendo en orden, los asuntos de una Iglesia y sociedad en caos.

Asumió el liderazgo cívico y espiritual de Italia, nombrando gobernadores de varias ciudades italianas. El que había gastado su propia riqueza para aliviar el sufrimiento de los pobres, hizo lo mismo con los recursos de la Iglesia. Tomó la iniciativa en la evangelización, enviando monjes benedictinos de su anterior Monasterio de San Andrés para convertir al pueblo de Gran Bretaña. Eligió a Agustín que era el prior para ser el líder de este proyecto. Ahora es conocido como San Agustín de Canterbury, y es considerado el Apóstol de los Ingleses.

El celo del papa Gregorio se extendió por todo el mundo conocido. Muchos de sus escritos han sobrevivido. Consideraba la predicación como la función indispensable de cada pastor. Su gran celo por la gloria de Dios, lo hizo reformar la música de la iglesia. El canto o música Gregoriana, que la iglesia todavía recomienda para la liturgia lleva su nombre.

Además de su madre, dos de las tías de Gregorio han sido canonizadas - las Santas Tarsilla y Æmiliana . Debido a esto, uno de los primeros biógrafos del Papa Gregorio habla acerca de su educación como siendo la de un santo entre los santos.

Llamado 'el Magno', Gregorio ha recibido un lugar con Agustín, Ambrosio y Jerónimo, como uno de los cuatro doctores más importantes y claves de la Iglesia Latina.

Es significativo del concepto de autoridad religiosa de san Gregorio que se llamara a sí mismo el Siervo de los siervos de Dios. Es una designación utilizada por los papas desde entonces.

Murió el 12 de marzo del año 604. Fue Papa durante 14 años. Es el santo patrón de los maestros.
