Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7th)

Counting prayers on beads is a very ancient form of praying. It has been used for 1000s of years in India. Hindus, Buddhists and Muslims also use beads to count prayers.

The Rosary (Latin - rosarium, 'rose-garden') is a method of prayer, which involves contemplating the mysteries of the life of Jesus, through the eyes of Mary, His mother and first disciple. The elements of the Rosary - beads, praying Hail Mary, meditating on the mysteries of Christ's life - have existed for centuries. They coalesce in the time of St Dominic in the 12th century. Christian tradition says that Our Lady gave St Dominic the Rosary. The Dominican pope St Pius V established the Rosary in its current form in 1569.

In the 15th century, the Dominican friar, Alan de la Roche, emerged as an outstanding preacher of the 'Psalter of Our Lady', a term he preferred to that of the Rosary. The title of this feast was changed from 'Holy Rosary' to 'Our Lady of the Rosary' in 1960.

The Psalter refers to the 150 Psalms. Before printing was invented, books were fabulously expensive. Most of the world was illiterate and poor and ordinary people did not own books. Often, only monasteries and churches had books. The Psalter was used for the daily recitation of prayers - something that continues to this day.

The ordinary people wanted to pray like the monks but had no books to read the psalms from. Not up to memorizing all 150 Psalms, they recited the Hail Mary, interspersed with the Our Father, in the place of each Psalm.

They strung 150 beads together, one for each Psalm, so they could keep count. Other prayers and meditations were added to this beaded string of 15 decades, until we arrived at the Rosary we have today.

As a prayer, the Rosary involves contemplating the mysteries of Christ through the eyes of the Blessed Virgin Mary, in company with her. This contemplation is the heart of the Rosary. Hence the Rosary is sharing in Our Lady's prayer, or praying as Our Lady herself prayed.

Scripture tells us that 'Mary kept all these words, pondering them in her heart' (Luke 2:19) and 'His mother kept all these words in her heart' (Luke 2:51). That is why Pope John Paul II wrote that the Rosary 'though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christocentric prayer'.

After a lifetime of saying over and over 'pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death', we could expect that Our Lady most certainly would. In Christian art, Our Lady of the Rosary is usually portrayed with the Baby Jesus, giving the rosary to St Dominic.

Nuestra Señora del Rosario (7 de octubre)

Contar las oraciones con cuentas es una forma muy antigua de orar. Se ha utilizado durante miles de años en la India. Los hinduistas, budistas y musulmanes también usan cuentas para contar las oraciones.

El Rosario (latín - rosarium, 'jardín de rosas') es un método de oración, que consiste en contemplar los misterios de la vida de Jesús, a través de los ojos de María, Su madre y primer discípulo. Los elementos del Rosario - las cuentas, rezar los Ave María, meditar sobre los misterios de la vida de Cristo - han existido durante siglos. Se incorporan en la época de Santo Domingo en el siglo XII. La tradición cristiana dice que Nuestra Señora le dio a Santo Domingo el Rosario. El papa dominico San Pío V estableció el Rosario en su forma actual en 1569.

En el siglo XV, el fraile dominico, Alan de la Roche, surgió como un destacado predicador del 'Salterio de Nuestra Señora', un término que prefería al del Rosario. El título de esta fiesta fue cambiado de 'Santo Rosario' a 'Nuestra Señora del Rosario' en 1960.

El Salterio se refiere a los 150 Salmos. Antes de que se inventara la imprenta, los libros eran extremadamente caros. La mayor parte del mundo era analfabeta y la gente pobre y corriente no poseían libros. A menudo, solo los monasterios y las iglesias tenían libros. El Salterio se utilizó para la recitación diaria de oraciones - algo que continúa hasta nuestros días.

La gente común quería orar como los monjes, pero no tenían libros para leer los salmos. Con la inhabilidad de memorizar los 150 Salmos, recitaron el Ave María, intercalado con el Padre Nuestro, en lugar de cada Salmo. Encadenaron 150 cuentas juntas, una para cada salmo, para poder mantener la cuenta. Se agregaron otras oraciones y meditaciones a esta cadena de cuentas de 15 décadas, hasta que llegamos al Rosario que tenemos hoy.

Como oración, el Rosario implica contemplar los misterios de Cristo a través de los ojos de la Santísima Virgen María, en compañía de ella.

Esta contemplación es el corazón del Rosario. Por lo tanto, el Rosario es compartir la oración de Nuestra Señora, u orar como Nuestra Señora misma oró.

Las Escrituras nos dicen que, 'María, por su parte, guardaba todas estas cosas, y las meditaba en su corazón' (Lucas 2.19), y 'Su madre conservaba cuidadosamente todas las cosas en su corazón' (Lucas 2.51). Es por eso que el Papa Juan Pablo II escribió que el Rosario, 'aunque claramente de carácter Mariano, es en el corazón una oración Cristo céntrica'.

Después de toda una vida de decir una y otra vez 'ruega por nosotros, pecadores, ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte', uno no puede más que esperar que Nuestra Señora lo haga. En el arte cristiano, Nuestra Señora del Rosario generalmente se representa con el Niño Jesús, entregando el rosario a Santo Domingo.
