- Family Reflection Questions:

- ***How to Approach the Bible***

- How do you feel about the Bible and reading scripture? Do you enjoy it, dislike it, or are you neutral to it? Why do you think you feel the way you do?
- Chat about the 5 interpretive strategies given by Bishop Barron and try to put them in your own words as a family.
- How could you as a family incorporate scripture into you life, or how have you? Why do you think this is important?

- ***John 1:1-18***

- John calls Jesus the “Word” of God. What does Bishop Barron say about that? Why is it significant?
- Do you believe Jesus Christ is truly this Word of God? Meaning, do you believe that Jesus is truly God from God, Light from Light, True God from True God? Why do you believe or not believe?
- The Incarnation (the Word becoming flesh) radically changed human history. What event(s) radically changed your history? How do you think that has affected your faith?
- John tells us that Jesus “tabernacled” or “pitched his tent among us.” How often do you think about God throughout your day? Do you try to remember that he walks with you?
- What do you find the most intriguing or beautiful about the North Rose window?
