THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

MARCH 15, 2020

Reflection by Rev. Leonard N. Peterson

For our ancient religious ancestors living in a small town, the well was an integral part of their daily routine. It was a natural setting for the women of the town, whose daily chores included fetching the water for the family household each morning before the heat of the day. Here they could chat with one another and add a little gossip.

Instead of literal water, we are nonetheless surrounded by the refreshing “water” of God’s mercy aplenty as dispensed by His Church in the sacrament of Reconciliation. Call it by its former name “Penance” or its nickname “Confession”; it is the same sacramental channel of grace. It is *the* refreshment for our thirsty souls, springing from a well that never runs dry. So why are so many of us letting our souls be parched these days? It cannot be that sin is no longer being committed, right?

Reading I: Exodus 17: 3-7 - The lack of drinking water brings down on Moses the wrath of his people. After asking for His help, Moses obeys the Lord and strikes a rock with his staff. That in turn brings forth water aplenty and revives Moses’ standing.

Reading II: Romans 5: 1-2, 5-8 - Paul asserts that God’s love is the blessed assurance of salvation for his brothers and sisters in the community. It is also his belief that “hope does not disappoint.”

Gospel: John 4: 5-42 - It was unheard of for a rabbi to speak in a familiar way with a woman in public, but even worse for a Jew to request water of a Samaritan. For Jesus, who does precisely both, He prefers to speak to the woman about “living water.” By that He meant “divine vitality, revelation and wisdom.” (**Worship Pgs. 1033**).

LENTEN SEASON

We begin the season of Lent. Canon Law urges all the Christian Faithful to offer special prayers, to perform works of piety and charity, and to mortify themselves by fulfilling their responsibilities more faithfully. They are likewise encouraged to perform acts of fast and abstinence.

FASTING requires that only one full meal a day be taken. Two smaller meals may be taken to maintain strength but these taken together should not equal another full meal. Fasting obliges from the 18th to the 59th birthday.

ABSTINENCE prohibits individuals the eating of meat. Abstinence obliges from the 14th birthday on. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

DAYS OF ABSTINENCE/ FASTING ARE: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

There is an additional **12 Noon Mass in the Parish Church** during Lent: Monday thru Friday.
