**Dear Parishioners,** in June of 2020 Pope Francis added three additional titles to the litany of Loreto. This prayer, a litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary, now includes the titles of Mary: “Mater misericordiae”, (Mother of mercy) “Mater spei” (Mother of hope), and solacium migrantium” (solace of migrants).

This Sunday, as the universal church observes the world day migrants and refugees, pope Francis encourages us, saying, “in encountering the diversity of foreigners, migrants and refugees, and in the intercultural dialogue that can emerge from this encounter, we have an opportunity to grow as church and to enrich one another.” Wherever the baptized find themselves, the pope says, they enhance the local church by their presence and contributions.

The church has been observing this day since 1914. This Sunday, Pope Francis “makes this appeal to journey towards an even wider “we” to all men and women, for the sake of renewing the human family, building together a future of justice and peace, and ensuring that no one is left behind.”
