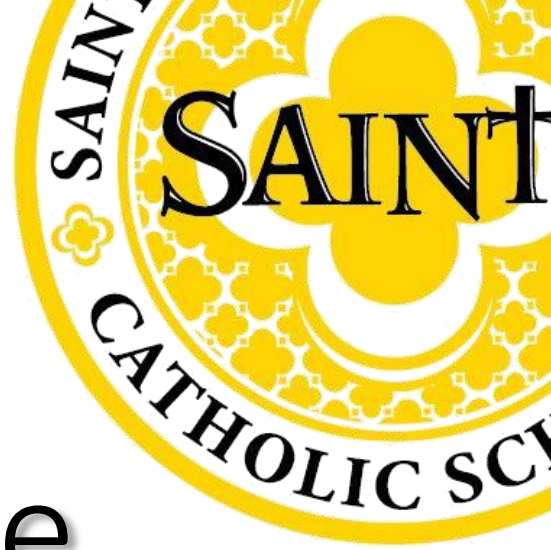

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Forward with Hope Re-Opening Plan

Over-Arching Priorities

- Catholic identity and mission must be at the center.
- We are “family” centered.
- Safety of student, teacher, and community is paramount.
- Academic excellence is a pillar for our Catholic schools.
- Students need teachers and teachers need students.
- We shall be practical, realistic, and flexible.
- Decisions will support all populations of students.
- Time in the school building should be maximized.





General Safety for Students

- **Health contract**
 - We must all work together and agree to measures of safety
- **Temperature checks**
 - Will be conducted before students enter the building
 - No student with a fever of 100.4 °F will be allowed in the building
 - Individuals should be fever-free for 24 hours without the aid of fever-reducing medicines
- **Handwashing is our #1 preventative measure.**
 - All students will wash/sanitize their hands immediately after entering the building and at least once each hour
- **Masking**
 - All students in grades K-8 will be required to wear a face covering over their nose and mouth (except for when eating, engaged in an activity where it may be unsafe, or those with a medical condition)



General Safety for Students

- **Calling in Sick Children**

- We will ask about your son's or daughter's symptoms. We must be notified if your child is tested for COVID-19

- **Diocesan Attendance Policy**

- This policy will be enforced on a case by case basis

- **Travel**

- If you travel to anywhere on the KDHE's quarantine travel list, you must quarantine for 14 days.

- **Vaccinations**

- All students and staff are recommended to receive the influenza immunization by November 2020.

- **Parent Contact**

- It is imperative that we have your most accurate contact information.

**SCENARIO A:
STABLE GROUPS**

- Providing distance between classrooms (stable groups)
- All students attend all days of the week

B

**SCENARIO B:
6-FOOT DISTANCE**

- Providing 6-foot distance between students
- All students attend all days of the week but not necessarily with their homeroom teacher

C

**SCENARIO C:
REMOTE LEARNING**

- At home learning for all
- Only select small groups attend for brief times



A Day in Scenario A

A

- **The drop-off and pick-up procedures will be altered to alleviate congestion for temperature checks.**
 - Alphabet split for north and south drop-off and pick-up
 - No parents, outside visitors or guests will be allowed to the building without an appointment.
- **Students will wash/sanitize their hands immediately after entering the building**
- **EDP will continue.**
 - Before 7:40 AM EDP will be in the gym by family groups
- **Lockers will be used twice per day when coats are needed.**
- **One-way routes will be identified in hallways and/or staircases.**





A Day in Scenario A

A

- **Students will stay with their stable groups throughout the day.**
 - Students will have assigned seats with their same peers throughout the day.
 - Elementary stable groups will be assigned specific restrooms in the school.
 - Stable groups will rotate sections of the playground during recess
- **In departmentalized grades, the teachers will move rooms.**
- **If students do move to different classrooms, all desks will be cleaned between switches.**
- **Elementary PE/music/art/etc. should be outside as much as possible.**
- **Schedules will be staggered within the school to alleviate hallway/restroom congestion.**
- **Students will use hand-sanitizer upon entering and exiting each room and at least once each hour.**
- **Lunch seating will be altered to maintain distancing.**
 - Students may be asked to eat lunch in various locations such as classroom, outside, etc.





A Day in Scenario A

A

- **Students will bring and use personal water bottles.**
- **Follow the Mass attendance guidelines for students.**
 - Tuesday and Thursday Masses will be split by grade levels.
- **Adoration and confession will continue with 6-foot social distancing.**
- **Middle school will have exploratory classes.**
- **Clubs will be decided at a later date.**
- **Student athletic practice will be directed by Kansas State High School Athletic Association and the Catholic School Activities League.**
- **No field trips away from campus or assemblies will be scheduled.**
- **Scheduled volunteers will have temperature taken upon arrival and must wear a mask.**





Scenario B

B

- Very similar to Scenario A except all students will maintain a 6-foot distance in the classrooms.
- If we can keep the classrooms staffed, every student will attend every day.





Scenario C



- Schools may be able to bring in small groups of no more than 9 students for individualized help.
- Schools will strive to offer internet-ready devices for each child in a family as needed.
- Participation and achievement grades will be earned by students.
 - For remote learning, when video sessions are hosted, participation grade will be issued.
- On days of remote learning, students will be expected to account for their studying by completing a daily log for **6 hours of learning**. Maintaining the log is a state requirement.
- For grades 3-8, we will utilize Microsoft Office 365 and Teams for live lessons and classroom assignments
- For grades PS-2, we will utilize Teams for live lessons and SeeSaw for classroom assignments
