***Tips for being a  
Catechist at Home***

- Create a lesson plan each week.
- Create a dedicated area for you and your child(ren) to do the work. This will help you to be focused.
- Create a prayer table in your home and change the environment of the table according to the liturgical calendar. (for example: each season has a different color make sure you have a cloth on the table that matches the season we are in. (purple (Advent), white (Christmas), green (Ordinary time, red (Pentecost)).
- Do not let work accumulate. Try to stay on a weekly schedule just like we would if the child is attending sessions in the parish.
- We have resources in the parish office that might help you with a certain topic please don't hesitate to ask.
- Make sure the child is doing the work and you are there to just share the faith.
- Be creative in the way you present a topic and try to refrain from just reading the chapters. There are great videos, books, and resources online to help you with this. Please visit [www.loyolapress.com](http://www.loyolapress.com)
