FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

**Dear Parishioners:**

.....Congratulations to the winners of the William H. Cron Scholarships - this is an endowment that the parish has through the efforts of the Cron Family and others to raise money for graduates of Epiphany School. When Epiphany School closed, the Cron Scholarship transferred to Christ the Teacher School for the Epiphany student/parishioner who graduated with the highest academic average...and who would be attending a Catholic High School. This year the scholarship is awarded to **Alyssa McCarthy**. Alyssa will receive \$1,000 per year for each of her four years at Immaculate Conception High in Lodi.

...Our Parish Finance Council has established the William H. Cron **College Scholarship** award and this year the one-time gift of \$2500 is awarded to **Emily McFadden**. Congrats to Emily and to Alyssa...Good Luck and God bless.

... I'd like you all to consider the RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults...for September...We are once again looking for adults who were never baptized and who would like to explore the Catholic faith...

...We're also looking for those who were baptized into another Christian denomination - like Lutheran - and who now are interested in converting to the Catholic faith...

...And we are also looking for those baptized Catholics who for whatever reason never received the sacraments of Confirmation and Communion...and now would like to prepare for them as adults...No commitments at this point...just good information. ...Our next **wish list items** for the **Heritage Fund** are:

1) Some Rectory Repairs...including the roof that connects the rectory to the Church...and also - the roof above the front door entrance to the Rectory...also about a dozen windows and frames that are rotting away and need replacing...and the gutter and down spout on the rear of the Rectory which detached and fell off during the winter...at an estimated cost of \$11,900.00.

2) The renovation of the bathroom in the Church next to the Daily Mass Chapel...which includes a new commode, a new vanity, new flooring, an exhaust fan, and a new paint job...at an estimated cost of \$4,000.00-\$5,000.00.
