Pastor's Message May 13, 2018

My dear parishioners and friends,

Happy Mothers' Day to all of you who have had the tremendous blessing to experience the joys and the challenges of bearing within your body and nurturing the gift of the life of your children!

Somewhat related to this celebration of Mother's Day, I want to tell you all about a new liturgical celebration that has just been added to the Church calendar. Pope Francis, this past month, has decreed that each year, on the Monday following the Feast of Pentecost, the Universal Church will celebrate the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church. (This year the feast falls on May 21.)

The title, "Mother of the Church", was first attributed to our Blessed Mother by St. Ambrose in the 4th Century. It fell into disuse until it was revived by the German Jesuit theologian Hugo Karl Erich Rahner in 1944. It recognizes Mary's role within the Church at its founding. Saint John Paul II addressed Mary's maternal relationship to all the faithful in his encyclical, *Redemptoris Mater* when he wrote, "Mary is present in the Church as the Mother of Christ, and at the same time as that Mother whom Christ, in the mystery of the Redemption, gave to humanity in the person of the Apostle John. Thus, in her new motherhood in the Spirit, Mary embraces each and every one in the Church, and embraces each and every one through the Church. In this sense Mary, Mother of the Church, is also the Church's model. Indeed, as Paul VI hopes and asks, the Church must draw from the Virgin Mother of God the most authentic form of perfect imitation of Christ."

Pentecost, which commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles as they gathered in prayer with Mary, is sometimes referred to as the birthday of the Church. What better gift can we celebrate in the Church than this feast by which we acknowledge Mary as our Mother?

JOURNEY TO THE HOLY LAND AND JORDAN

Join Epiphany Church and Our Lady of Mercy Church as we travel to the Holy Land and Jordan. Experience, feel and see the wonders and physical manifestations of our faith and beliefs as we venture into the holiest places on earth – moments that will move you!! It will be November 5-14, 2018. Father Bruce Harger will be the Spiritual Director and the cost is \$3,490 per person, based on double occupancy. The single supplement is \$535. Cost includes one round-trip ticket, hotel accommodations, Continental breakfast and dinner, air-conditioned motorcoach, entrance fees and professional guide. Plane will leave from Newark Airport and the trip is being handled by Holy Land and Beyond LLC. Points of call are: Ben-Gurion Air Port; Nazareth (the Basilica of the Annunciation/St. Joseph Church), Mary's well/Mt. of Precipice/Nazareth, Galilee (overnight); Mt. Tabor/Cana – (renewal of marriage vows in the church of the wedding); crossing to the Kingdom of Jordan, Journey to Petra; crossing the border to Israel/Eliat/Arava Valley/Negev Desert/Dead Sea; Bethlehem; the Pools of Bethesda/Via Delorosa, Western Wall; Mt. of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Road to Emmaus/Joppa/Tel-Aviv.
