*My dear parishioners,*

I announce to you today that I have appointed the Reverend  
Bruce E. Harger, pastor of Church of the Epiphany, Cliffside Park, New  
Jersey.

Father Harger comes to you with many years of fine priestly  
experience. In all his assignments, he has been a faithful representative of  
Our Lord, ministering to the needs of people with tremendous dedication  
and zeal.

A Pastor is to care for his people, preach the good news of Jesus  
Christ, and make them holy by celebrating the Sacraments. He works in  
harmony with his Bishop, “to bring the faithful together like a unified  
family so that they may be led effectively through Christ in the Holy Spirit

that the Lord may give him the holiness and strength he needs to carry out
