

## Expectations of a Titan Teacher

Trinity Junior High and High School is a private, Catholic school. She is founded upon the teachings of the Catholic Church and her rich traditions.

- ❖ Each day at school, in my classroom or out of my classroom, I will speak and act in a way that does not offend Catholic teaching.
- ❖ In the case of disagreement or confusion on a teaching regarding faith and morality, I will bring this to the school chaplain discreetly and respectfully.
- ❖ I will be a living witness to the Gospel, modeling the virtues of joy, kindness, and confidence.
- ❖ I will attend all-school monthly Masses, prayers services, and other liturgical and spiritual events held in the school.
- ❖ I will (or choose a student to) begin every class during the day with prayer. With the exception of 1<sup>st</sup> period, every period ought to begin with a prayer.

The school day at Trinity Junior High and High School begins at 8:20am with the first bell, and concludes at 3:20 with the final bell.

- ❖ As a faculty member, I will be in the school building no later than 8:00am and leave no earlier than 3:45pm.
- ❖ Exceptions to this are to be given to Father Hochhalter via email, phone call, or in person with due consideration to timing and care for students.
- ❖ I will be in my classroom or at the door during an operating class.
- ❖ I will NOT use my cell-phone for any reason during class time, and if the need arises, I will notify students the reason behind the usage. (e.g. family emergency, professional reasons)

- ❖ I will direct my special attention outside of the school day to the co-curricular activities of the students (e.g. coaching, supervising, spectating)
