What to Bring:

*All items should be clearly labeled with the child's name.

- Packed lunch (microwave available, please place an ice pack into student's lunch bags since there isn't enough refrigerator space for everyone. Also, please remember we are a peanut/tree nut free school). It is also recommended that you try not to send things that need heating up unless that is your only option. We have 2 microwaves; however, it takes a lot of time if 20 children need to heat something up. It just doesn't give them enough time to eat, plus they have to wait their turn. It works a lot better if you can send it in a thermos already heated for your child.
- Water Bottle **THIS MUST GO BACK & FORTH DAILY - NO WATERFOUNTAINS WILL BE USED**
- Sunscreen (this can be kept at the school)
- Appropriate clothing for hands on fun: t-shirt, shorts, tennis shoes, & light jacket (No sandals please)

Theme Weeks:

Each week will be centered on a theme. Students will create theme related projects/crafts. In addition, each week we will be doing Bible lesson to strengthen our students' faith.
