ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL 2016 - LOVE NEVER FAILS

The Catholic Center needs every member's participation to make our goal of \$50,000 for 2016. We have not yet received sufficient pledges to meet our goal and statistics show that we need to overachieve in pledges in order to get sufficient payments to close the gap. We are currently \$15,000 short of goal in total pledges! Last year over 300 members participated. This year we have only 160 participating. If another 100 members would pledge \$150 each, that would put us on track to make the goal. Any shortfall at the end of the year will be paid out of the Catholic Center's operating expenses. If we exceed our goal, any overage will be returned to the Catholic Center in full to be used for student scholarships.
