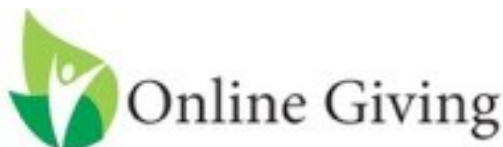

- INTERFAITH HOSPITALITY NETWORK



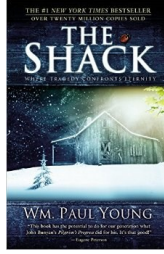
