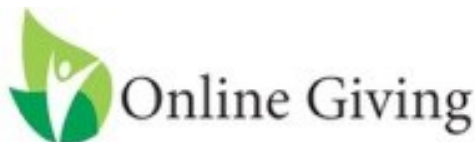
October 16 - University Nursing/ Rehabilitation Center
