Building and Grounds Update

You may have noticed on your way into mass that we are in the middle of a facilities project. Due to the age and corrosion of the gas lines on our property, we are having to replace all underground gas lines. As good stewards, the finance committee has approved \$20,000 for this required project with funding from the MRR Account (Major Repair and Renewal).

How Will This Project Affect You?

On Monday, January 21st from 8AM to 5PM, the chapel, center hall, office and parking lots will be closed to all. Evening activities will not be affected and will continue as scheduled.

The following day, Tuesday, January 22nd from 8AM to 5PM, the chapel and the entrance and exit from Lumpkin Street will be closed. Please use the Cloverhurst Ave entrance during these hours. Evening activities will not be affected and will continue as scheduled.

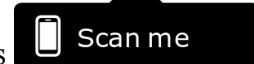
Join us for our 41st Human Race at the Catholic Center. Registration is \$20 with proceeds going towards campus ministry outreach and activities.
