"Upendo" means love in Tanzania. The Upendo Children's Home is an orphanage run by the Sisters' of the Precious Blood in Moshi, Tanzania. Long-time Catholic Center member, Dr. Lioba Moshi works closely with the Upendo Children's home. Around 60 children from newborn to age 5, often with disabilities, are placed in this home. Unfortunately, at age 5, the children age-out and must move to a state-run orphanage with very poor conditions. The non-profit, **Upendo-One Kid at a Time** has been created to raise funds to build a second facility for the children once they turn 5.
