

# WHAT TO EXPECT RETURNING TO MASS

- Everyone will be wearing a mask
- Everyone will be asked to use the hand sanitizer stations in the atrium
- Everyone will continue to social distance remaining six feet apart at all times

## SEATING:

- Access to the church will only be allowed through the atrium
- Pews will be labelled for a single person or a household of up to two through six
- Ushers will be available for assistance

## DURING THE LITURGY:

- Singing by the congregation has been temporarily suspended
- All missalettes have been removed from the church
- The Sign of Peace will not be offered to non-household members with a handshake

## RECEPTION OF THE EUCHARIST:

- ***The Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ is received under either species.***
- The Body of Christ will be placed in the communicant's hand (no gloves)
- The distribution of the Precious Blood is temporarily discontinued
- There will be markers on the floor indicating where to stand as you await the reception of the Eucharist

## DISMISSAL:

- In order to avoid crowding at the church doors the ushers will dismiss the congregation in sections
- Church will be sanitized between Masses
