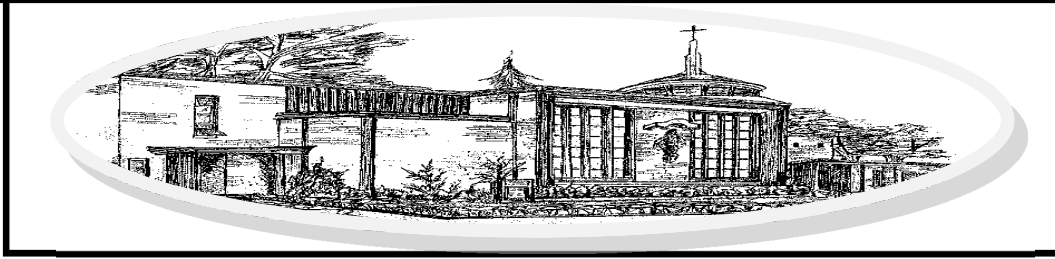

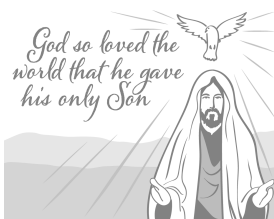

May we who have the flexibility to care for our children when their schools close remember those who have no options;

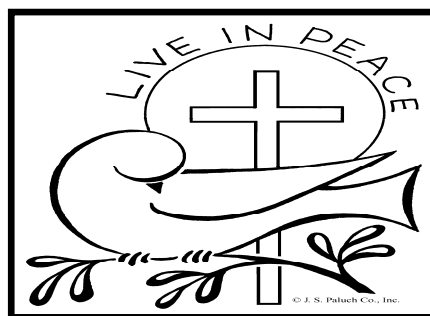
May we who have to cancel our trips remember those who have no place to go;

## Volunteers Needed

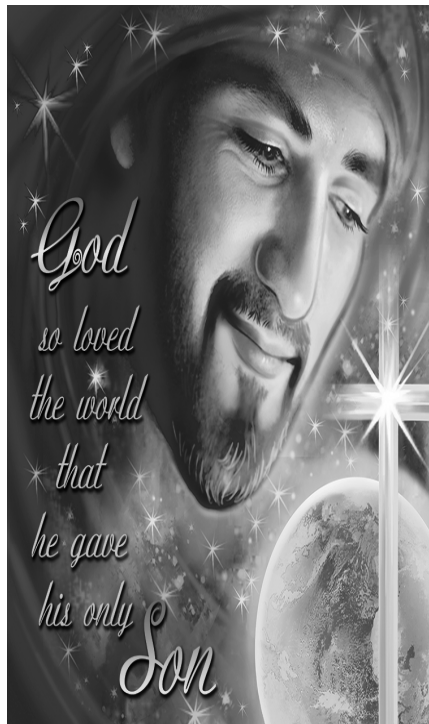
