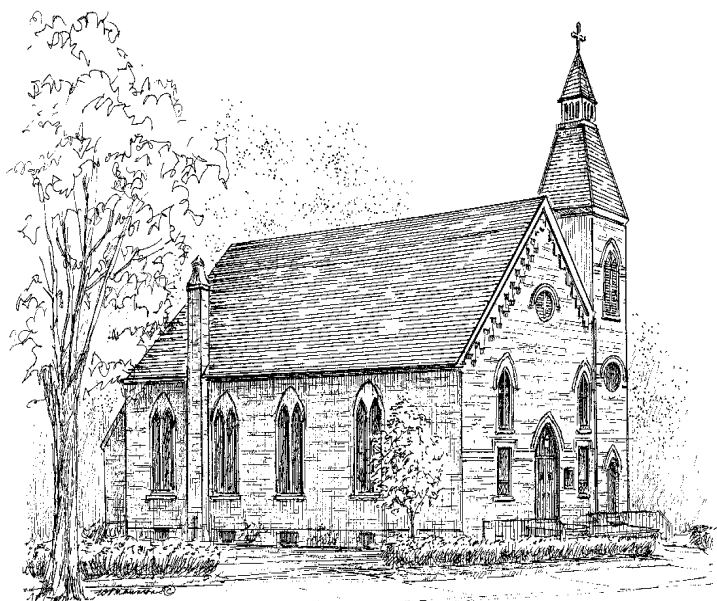

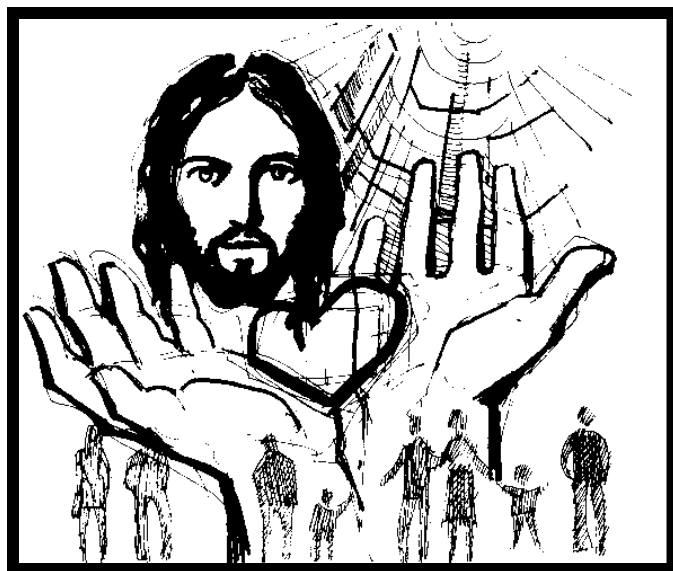

Attendance slewed toward 11 AM, yet the respectable total congregation numbers were on par with the previous few weeks. * * From the starred income above, we took about 3 % for the Second Collection for Catholic Missions Among First Peoples and Peoples of Color. Our parish's total response to that Collection became \$ 485 and the Offertory was lowered to \$ 2,440 -- not so hot for high summer in Wurtsboro, more than \$ 1,000 less than July 4th.

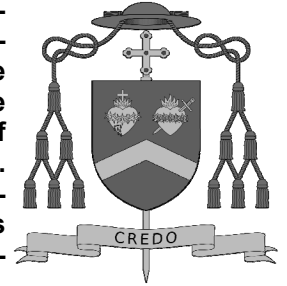
"RIDE FOR A CAUSE"

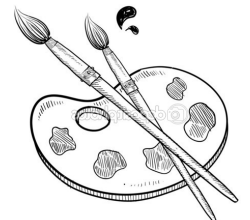
