**SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND**



"What now ?" you inevitably must think. These collections come around with a mazing frequency ! Yes they do. That's because basic human need is always hovering, begging for our attention. Those who closely follow global news will know that Africa is a tinderbox. The advances in democracy, essential freedoms and financial security

made in the last decades of the Twentieth Century are threatened by Muslim extremists, repressive dictatorships, strong-arm military tactics, enormous debt, epidemics of dreadful diseases, poverty and violence fueled by centuries' old tribal hatreds. The Christian churches stand as witness to human cruelty, oases of care and safety and beacons of light in the gathering darkness. Our own Fr. Matthias can attest to the struggle as it plays out in his Nigerian homeland. Cardinal Dolan, in his letter about the Collection, pointed out that, in such fraught circumstances, "it is difficult for the Church to sustain its growth and maintain pastoral outreach. The *Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa* provides grants for pas-toral projects, schools, evangelization and education of clergy and lay ministries." Our parish will "tithe" about 3 % of next weekend's Offertory. Your gift, using the envelope in your boxed set, will help greatly.
