PRESENTATION OF THE LORD—

Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary; on Thursday this week, we celebrate the Feast of Candlemas. This is the last of the Christmas feasts when the Prophetess Anna and the Holy Man Simeon recognize the Infant Jesus as “the light to enlighten the Gentiles.” On this day, the Church blesses the candles to be used for the year in the Church, and the Faithful may bring candles to be blessed to take home for devotional use. Candles will be blessed at both Masses.
