William writes: **Thanks:** My sincere thanks to Father Benedict for "holding the fort" for the past 9 days that I was away at St. Michael's Abbey. : **The Abbey and Southern CA:** I got to see most of our fathers; all those who live, pray, and work at the Abbey and those who, based at the San Pedro Priory, staff Ss. Peter and Paul Parish, Wilmington, and Mary Star of the Sea High School. I didn't get to see our community at St. John the Baptist Parish, Costa Mesa. The active Norbertine Sisters at Ss. Peter and Paul, the 3 Foundresses from Slovakia, now number 8 sisters with 5 young American women. They work in the Parish School and attend to a food pantry and other practical works for the poor.
