Dominica I Passionis ~ I. classis

Fr. William writes: We are coming to the end of Lent. In the Extraordinary

Form Calendar, a new season begins today, **Passiontide**. Though this name is not used in the Ordinary Form Calendar - it is the 5th Week of Lent - nevertheless some aspects of the Passiontide mood are present in the revised Liturgy. In the Extraordinary Form it is compulsory to veil the crucifixes and images and in the Ordinary Form the veiling is an optional practice. The only images not veiled are the Stations of the Cross, and those too high to reach such as the statuary on the High Altar. The veils on crucifixes are removed on Good Friday to reveal the image of the Crucified Savior and emphasize His death. The veils on sacred images are removed at the Easter Vigil. The Temporary veiling of the crosses and sacred images in the penitential violet of Lent is a beautiful custom that helps us to reflect on the deeper spiritual and theological meaning of the season.
