**Fr. William writes:** The date set by the Diocese for our Parish Confirmation is Sunday 29th April. There are candidates for Confirmation in the Extraordinary Form (Old Form in Latin) and the Ordinary Form (New Form in English). Bishop Spalding was prepared to come and Confirm **all the candidates but only in the Ordinary Form**. Being made aware of the desire of greater number of families in the current eligible group to receive Confirmation in the Extraordinary Form, and that only two candidates would be coming forward for the Ordinary Form, the Bishop has graciously delegated me to administer the Sacrament on April 29th in both forms at the two Sunday Masses. Bishop Spalding hopes to visit the Parish and offer Mass in the Ordinary Form sometime this year, perhaps on the Solemnity of the Assumption, our Patronal Feast Day.

**40 Days For Life:** Jericho March for the closing of 40 Days for Life begins TODAY at 2pm. Bring your palms with you as we walk 7 times around Planned Parenthood. The shofar horn will be blown at the end of Jericho March!
