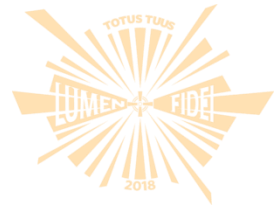

FR. WILLIAM WRITES This coming week is an eventful week with Assumption Parish hosting Totus Tuus (Pope St. John Paul II's motto: "Totally Yours"). Totus Tuus is a summer Catholic Youth Program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic Faith through Evangelization, Catechesis, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship. Our guests officially include children from St. Mary of the Seven Sorrows and Holy Name Parishes who are sharing the costs with Assumption. We have accepted enrollment of children from St. Ann, Christ the King, St. Edward, S. Pius X, St. Lawrence, St. Henry and St. Matthew. After the Searcy Memorial Thanksgiving Meal, Totus Tuus is our largest "ministry event" in the year. All are welcome to the additional 11.15am Mass each day Monday 16th to Friday 20th. All are welcome too for the POT LUCK DINNER at 6.30 pm on Wednesday 18th, just bring some food to share. **Totus Tuus is still accepting sign-ups on Sunday night when the Youth program begins or Monday morning when the children's program begins.** I leave for the Netherlands and the General Chapter of the Norbertine Order on Friday 20th July and return on 5th August. For the first week of my absence, Father Jerome from St. Michael's Abbey in Silverado, Orange County, CA will be here in the Rectory. When Father leave to preach a Retreat early on Sunday 29th, the Masses and Confessions will be covered by Fathers Gilstrap, Hammond, Halladay and Fr. Bede Price O.S.B. Please make Fr. Jerome and the other priests welcome. Please pray for the Chapter, especially as part of its business is to elect a new Abbot General for the Order and a new Definitory (General Council).
