Father William Writes: *It's great to be back! What a chore it was getting from Dusseldorf airport to the (former) Abbey of Rolduc, now with just one wing a Seminary, and the rest a Hotel and Conference Center, near the town of Kerkrade in the Netherlands. Others travelling from the USA also had some difficulty getting there from Dusseldorf Airport - a journey of about 60 miles, via trains and buses. It was wonderful to meet up with 111 priests, brothers and sisters from our Order, several of whom I am acquainted with from 2 General Chapters I attended in 1982, and 1988. We elected a new Abbot General Jos Wouters, a 59 year old Belgian Abbot, as well as a new Definitory (Council of 4 Abbots) to govern the Norbertine Order; some other officials were confirmed in office. The Abbot General will remain in office until the General Chapter nearest his 75th birthday. I was a post-graduate student in Rome with the Abbot General from 1989-1991. There were some good changes made to our Constitutions and Statutes and many updates given on the status of the various Canonries of our Order. We were able on Sunday 29th July to visit the Norbertine Abbey of Berne in Heeswijk and the Monastery of Norbertine Canonesses at Oosterhout, both in Holland. On Wednesday 1st August we visited St. Norbert's birthplace at Gemep in Germany and the city of Xanten and St. Martin's Collegiate Church where St. Norbert was educated and served as a Canon prior to founding our Order. I offered my resignation as Prelate-Administrator of the Irish Norbertines to the new Abbot General. Abbot Jos spoke kind words of appreciation for my service and a temporary Administrator was named for the Irish Canonry which will elect a Prior de Regimine (a ruling Prior) probably in October. I was very happy to hand over the responsibilities which I had as Prelate for the Irish Canonry of our Order for the last five years. The return journey was easier as some of the American contingent hired a small bus to take us directly to Dusseldorf and the Airport. I arrived back around 10 pm on Sunday 5th August with Luke Wilgenbush waiting for me at the airport.*

I am very grateful to the priests who cared for the Parish in my absence, assisted ably by our Seminarian Luke and Mrs. Jerilyn Rost our Office Manager. I prayed for the Parish in the places made holy by the presence of St. Norbert (1080-1121). In 2021 on Christmas Day our Order will be 900 years old. Please pray for us that we may be faithful to the five ends of our Order given us by St. Norbert and that our Order will have a new spring-time in post-Christian Europe. The five ends: (1) Praise of God in the Choir Office (2) Devotion to the Sacrament of the Altar (3) Devotion to the Immaculate Mother of God (4) Zeal for souls (5) A spirit of penance in reparation for sin.

Our Patronal Feast will be marked on Wednesday, 15th of August, with Low Mass in the Extraordinary Form at 10am, and Solemn Mass with Bishop Spalding at 6pm—his first visit to our Parish. There will be a reception in Buddeke House after the Bishop's Mass A light supper will be provided. Please try to be there
