PRAYERS FOR MSGR. BERNARD NIEDERGESES, our former Parish Priest at Assumption, are requested as he is currently in St. Thomas Hospital.

40 DAYS FOR LIFE (Wednesday September 26th - Sunday 4th November) will be inaugurated in the Diocese of Nashville with Holy Mass at 6.00pm this Wednesday. We are proud to provide our church for this special Mass. A Candle Light Prayer Service will follow at 7.30pm after the Mass outside Planned Parenthood at 412 Dr. D.B. Todd Blvd. Catechism Study Group is cancelled this coming Wednesday because of the Pro-Life activities. Our Parish has been allocated the time period from 7am to 12 noon each Thursday for prayerful presence outside Planned Parenthood - see if you can make it there.

OKTOBERFEST is fast approaching however only 13 parishioners have volunteered to help on Saturday 13th October. We need people to help with the parking arrangements, set up before and clean up afterwards, helping in the children's play area, staffing food, beer, drinks, and baked good stalls as well as signing up to bake items for that stall. Some may be willing to conduct tours for visitors in the church - an opportunity for evangelism. We really need help with all this. RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM : It is gratifying to know that this year we have 55 students: 47 at the Elementary School level and 7 at the High School level. Our thanks to the Co-Directors Kay Bulzacchelli and Freddy Quiteno and the teachers for their work for the rising generation.

A new development is happening among **THE YOUNG ADULTS OF OUR PARISH**. The existing "Faith and Philosophy" group will merge with a new National Catholic Young Adults' Program called **i.d. 9:16**. ID stands for "Intentional Disciples" and the 9:16 is a reference to St. Paul's words in First Corinthians: "For if I preach the Gospel, that gives me no ground for boasting. For necessity is laid upon me. Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel!!!" This is an exciting program which makes upbeat live streaming presentations available to groups for their formation, and the young adults (18 upwards - some single, some young married) will engage in works of the apostolate for the spreading of the Gospel. We can expect good fruits from this innovative program.
