The Searcy Thanksgiving Meal is our major annual outreach for the needy and shut in people of the area. It creates the smallest inconvenience of closing down the Sunday morning social time between Masses - just once in the year; nobody with a conscience could object to that! There are local businesses for social gathering on this one Sunday, such as the Red Bicycle Cafe on 5th Avenue North, where socializing can be relocated. I implore every able bodied parishioner to get involved for even just an hour on Thanksgiving Day to have the food served and carried to those in need. Please do your best to be there, anytime from 7.00AM onwards. The Solemnity of Christ the King will be celebrated on Sunday 25th November. After 11am Mass there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until 3.00pm when the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be recited, Vespers of the day Sung, and Benediction to conclude the celebration. Please consider spending some time with Our Lord on this great Feast Day.
