**I am sorry if I did not seem very present during this past week.** It has taken time to get back into the swing of things after the end of the Christmas Season, then a retreat, and this last week, various pre-surgical procedures. Also Mrs. Laura Cooper and her husband are away Thursday 24th till Monday 28th, so Mrs. Kay Bulzuchelli stood in part of the day Thursday 24th, and 8am-3pm on Friday 25th. **The Office will be closed on Monday 28th.** Mrs. Cooper will be back in the usual 8am to 4pm office day from Tuesday 29th January. I also filled in for the 8am Masses on Tuesday 22nd and Wednesday 23rd January at St. Pius X Parish, Bordeaux. Last night at 10pm I celebrated Mass for 60 Catholic High School students and their supervisors from the Diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska who were visiting Nashville and came to Assumption for the late night Mass before an early start travelling back on Sunday morning.
