Fr. William Writes

Thank you so much for your prayers! The 3 hour surgery last Tuesday went well. The surgeon found that that Femoral Head (a ball-shaped piece of bone at the top of the femur), was in fragments: no wonder there was pain! Already there is considerable relief with the total hip replacement. There will be some more pain yet, wound pain, but I believe the worst is over. It's great to have my Norbertine confrere, Father Charles here until February 8th when he will return to the Abbey. I am very well otherwise and as you see by this bulletin column, I am already back in action.

The bill for the replacement of 18 of the 20 Altar spot lights

came in this week from TEAM Electrical Contracting. I remarked before in this column about the respectful and professional way the men who did the work: setting up scaffolding, an hydraulic lift; and placing a board to protect sanctuary surfaces as they worked, conducted themselves. The bill was \$1,746.00.

We had unwanted and uninvited animal and bird interlopers

in the ceiling above the Servers' Sacristy. The Company we use for difficulties with the local wildlife is **Animal Pros**. The cost for securing the space and closing off entry to the birds and beasts came to \$1,923.00.

A very important Parish Pastoral Council Meeting

will be held on Thursday 14th February, St. Valentine's Day! Among the issues to be considered is a proposal for commercial use of our Parking Lot during times when no Church activity is being held and various issues concerning plumbing and the flooring in Fr. Bernard Hall after a recent termite invasion . It seems likely that the City will, before long, start to place parking meters in the neighborhood streets. Our parking space is an important asset.

A timely gift of \$1,000 was received from the German-

town Neighborhood Association. The Association was expressing gratitude for our permission to place a sculpture: "Island Queen" by Doug Schatz in our green space at 1213 Seventh Avenue North, for a period of two years. The Tennessee November 30th Register says: "The sculpture consisting of 6 bright red spires, is located across from the Historic Strobel House. It was placed in honor of Schatz's father, Walter Schatz, and Charles Strobel, who were boyhood friends. The official dedication occurred on Sunday 2nd December at 1:45pm.
