Fr. William Writes

Sexagesima Sunday, is the name for the second of three pre-Lent Sundays before Ash Wednesday in the Old Roman Rite liturgical calendar.

Floor in Fr. Bernard Hall: Flooring near the wall at the opposite end to the kitchen has been eaten away by termites. While the termites have been eradicated, the flooring needs to be replaced at the cost of \$5,800.00. The Parish Council unanimously encouraged me to proceed. We are waiting for the repairs to be scheduled.

For the **Plumbing in Fr. Bernard Hall** which is in need of repairs we are still waiting an appraisal.
