Quinquagesima Sunday (Extraordinary Form)

Fr. William Writes

Quinquagesima Sunday, is the name for the last of three pre-Lent Sundays before Ash Wednesday in the Old Roman Rite liturgical calendar.

Busy times: There is a lot happening at the present time. **40 Days For Life** is a major preoccupation as it should be. The **right to life** is so fundamental that it deserves pride of place on our personal and parish agendas. After 6pm Mass on Ash Wednesday, I hope a good representation of Assumption Parishioners will appear at Planned Parenthood for the peaceful and prayerful witness to life.
