Fr. William Writes

The Parish Pastoral Council met on Thursday 14th March at Buddeke House; my notes this week are a report of that meeting. There were some significant matters discussed. One is the future of the **Young Adult i.d.9:16 Program**. The Parish bought into this program for the current year but our sponsorship with be coming up for review. Anyone with an opinion on this should speak with me, or with Mark and DayNa Gliebe or Chris and Cassi Frazier. Certainly there is need for a Young Adult Group to continue but whether or not it will be in the i.d.9:16 format is the question. **Totus Tuus the Summer Catholic Youth Program** will be held this summer and a meeting in early April will be held with representatives of St. Mary's Parish and Holy Name Parish who partner with Assumption to bring planning forward. **Following up from the Parking Lot Meeting** the practicalities will be dealt with an final decisions made by the Parish Finance Committee: Ron Westphal, Rick Fisher, Kay Bulzacchelli, Jim Ladieu, Matt Ramsey, and myself. **40 Days for Life is well underway; please note the details in this bulletin.** Consideration was given to a report from the **Recent Oktoberfest Meeting on 4th March**. The Chairman is Freddie Quiteno and in next week's bulletin the names of the Chairpersons for the various committees will be given so **you may volunteer**. **First Communion Sunday (5th May) and May Crowning (12th May)** were discussed and I mentioned that I have invited **Bishop Spalding to celebrate Mass on the Parish Feast Day August 15th** and to share a supper with us after the 6pm Mass. **The Last Day for Religious Education this current school year** will be Sunday 19th May. **The termite-damaged flooring in Fr. Bernard Hall** has been replaced and awaits one more coat of polyurethane. The plumbing repairs in the Hall involving connection of the kitchen sinks to the metro sewer should have been completed yesterday. **A Spring Swing Dance (Fundraiser) will be held on Saturday 18th May** in Buddeke House; mark up your diary! Finally, for the information of Parishioners, the Office Manager (Mrs. Jerilyn Rost) worked 2/3 of her time for our Parish and 1/3 of her time for St. Pius Parish with her salary paid by Assumption alone. **With the coming of Mrs. Laura Cooper as Office Manager since September 2018, Fr. Halladay, the Administrator of St. Pius decided to reimburse Assumption for 1/3 of the salary.** I am grateful for this new financial arrangement. **The City will be marking two handicapped parking places** opposite the gate to the side church yard giving access to the ramp and door by Our Lady's Altar. **Bishop Spalding is keen to have strong representation from the Parishes for the Chrism Mass**, on April 17th at 6:30 pm, Sagrado Corazon church at the Catholic Pastoral Center 2800 McGavock Pike, Nashville. This is the Mass at which the Sacred Oil of Chrism is Consecrated (for use at Baptisms, Confirmations, Ordinations and the Consecration of Churches), the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens (for pre-Baptismal anointing) are blessed.
