THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

MARCH 24, 2019

Fr. William Writes

Tomorrow, March 25th, is the last of the great Feasts in Lent, **The Annunciation of the Lord**. It is 9 months before Christmas, the beginning of the life of Our Lord in this world, in the safety of His Mother's womb....yes, "the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us". Of this beautiful Feast, good Pope Benedict XVI wrote: " We praise (Our Lady) for giving us the Redeemer and we put our trust in her as the Mother whom her divine Son bequeathed to us from the Cross. For this reason, we invoke her frequently as "our hope" because she has shown us Jesus and passed down to us the great things which God constantly does for humanity. She does so simply, as a mother teaches her children at home." So tomorrow in a special way, let us open our hearts to receive Our Lord, and let us also honor His Mother. Mass will be offered at Noon in the Extraordinary Form (Latin). In the Cathedral of the Incarnation on West End, at 5.30pm, Fr. John Sims Baker, known to many of you, will celebrate Mass for his Silver Jubilee of the Sacred Priesthood. **Fr. Bernard**

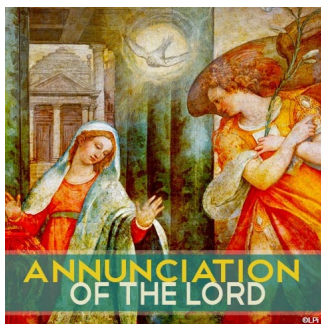
