**FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT**

APRIL 7, 2019

*Passion Sunday*

**Fr. William Writes**

**Passiontide, in our Liturgical Year** is the name given to the last two weeks of Lent, beginning on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, or Passion Sunday as named in the Extraordinary Form classical Latin Liturgy. Passiontide ends on Holy Saturday night as the Easter Vigil begins. In the Churches of the Catholic Roman Rite and some other mainstream denominations, all crucifixes and images that can be reached may be covered in veils (usually violet, the color of the vestments in Lent) starting on Passion Sunday: The crucifixes are to be covered until the end of the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday. Statues and images remain covered until the beginning of the Gloria at the Mass of Easter Vigil. This veiling is associated with the old Passion Sunday Gospel (John 8:46-59) which says that Jesus "hid Himself" from the people. In the Extraordinary Form Mass Psalm 42 of the "Prayers at the Foot of the Altar" is omitted as is the short doxology (*Gloria Patri "Glory be to the Father..."*) at the *Introit and in other parts of the Liturgy,*

**Palms will be blessed in the courtyard** before **both Masses** next Sunday, so please assemble there next weekend. Because of the **Chrism Mass on Wednesday of Holy Week (17th April)** there will be **no Adoration, Confessions, or 6.00pm Mass here** on that day, however there will be a 12 Noon Extraordinary Form Mass both on Monday (15th) and Wednesday (17th) of Holy Week.

It is hoped that our **Parking Lot will be marked with paint showing the correct way to park** thus allowing the maximum number of cars to park there - this coming week if possible. Please cooperate willingly with this arrangement for the good of all.
